DIMENSIONS

Measurements (In Inches)	Minimum	Maximum
Postcards	3 ½ X 5	4 1/4 X 6
Letters (includes oversize postcards)	3 ½ X 5	6 X 10 ½
Flats	6 1/8 X 11 ½	12 X15

RATE CLASSIFICATION

STANDARD - Mailing must have at least 200 pieces. (There is no standard postcard rate, only a first class postcard rate.) FIRST CLASS - Mailing must have at least 500 pieces. NON PROFIT - Owner must be registered as a non profit organization with the USPS and use the exact registered name and address in the return address block.

Does your piece meet the requirements for these characteristics?

□ Dimension (See chart to the left)
□ Aspect Ratio (Length by height = 1.3-2.5)
□ Thickness (Min. of 0.009 if larger than 4 1/4 x 6)
□ Contrast (Between paper color & address)
□ Folding (Final fold on the bottom, see your rep.)
□ Tabbing (Varies on finishing, see your rep.)
(Minimum of 2 tabs on folded self-mailers)

(Special tabbing required on booklets)

- □ Address Block (Use chart below)
- ☐ Indicia (Check permit number & rate class)
