

Sunlight and Watering: **Full sun with** moderate watering.

# **Planting:**

In sandy soil, 2 inches deep is better. Cover and keep watered until seeds sprout in 7 to 10 days. When first true leaves appear (the second set of leaves); thin plants to about 2 feet apart. Depending on the variety, sunflowers will mature and develop seeds in 80 to 120 days

**When to Plant:** Mid to Late May. (You can also sow a new row every 2 to 3 weeks to enjoy continuous blooms (until the first frost)





#### **Ingredients:**

4 medium chicken breasts
(boneless, skinless)
1 tablespoon Italian seasoning
1/2 tsp EACH crushed red
pepper, salt, pepper
1 tablespoon olive oil
2 tablespoons butter (divided)
1 pound asparagus (trimmed
and cut in 3rds)
1/2 cup onion (minced)
3-4 cloves garlic (minced)
1 cup heavy cream
2 tablespoons lemon juice
1/4 cup Parmesan cheese
(optional)

#### **Directions**:

Season chicken with Italian seasoning, crushed chili pepper, salt & pepper.

Add 1 tablespoon olive oil to a large skillet over medium heat.

Add chicken to the pan and cook for 5-6 minutes per side.

Remove from skillet and set aside.

Add butter onion, and asparagus to the skillet and cook for 2-3 minutes, or until just tender.

Add the garlic and cook for just under a minute.

Add heavy cream, lemon juice, and parmesan cheese; stir to combine.

Return chicken to the pan and simmer 3-4 minutes or until the sauce has thickened.

Salt & pepper if needed. Add broth if too thick.







#### **Ingredients**:

1 cup unsalted butter ,room temperature pinch of kosher salt 8 small strawberries ,stems removed, chopped 1/4 cup honey

#### **Directions:**

In a medium bowl, crush strawberries using a potato masher (you should end up with 1/2 cup); set aside.

Place butter and salt in the bowl of a food processor; pulse a few times until butter is fluffy. Scrape down the sides, if necessary.

Add in the mashed strawberries; pulse several more times until incorporated. Add in the honey and pulse until incorporated, and light and fluffy.

Leave on the counter for a couple days or transfer to an airtight container and refrigerate until needed (bring to room temperature before serving.)
