

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

January 18, 2022

The Jewell County Commissioners met Tuesday, January 18, 2022, at 8:30a.m. Commissioners Steve Greene, Brent Beck and Keith Roe were present. Carla J. Waugh, County Clerk was present for the meeting.

The minutes of the January 10, 2022, County Commissioners meeting were approved.

The Commissioners discussed a 2% increase for all hourly employees effective May or June 2022. They will review the financial ramifications.

Joel Elkins, General Superintendent, discussed bridge and road maintenance projects. Commissioners and Joel discussed plans for the overlay on the four miles of Y road east of Highway 14.

Don Jacobs, Sheriff, discussed personnel attending training. Don said that the 2021 Dodge Durango that was approved for purchase was already sold. He had vehicle pricing from JR Audio Emergency Vehicle Outfitter on the following:
