Chapter Meeting Date: October 16, 2023

<u>Call to Order</u> – President Sylvester Taylor officially called the meeting to order at 6:32 PM.

<u>Invocation</u> – Jerome Jones provided the opening prayer.

<u>Parliamentary Procedures</u> – William Buchanan reviewed the parliamentary procedures and provided rules to making a motion. Greetings and Welcome Message:

- Sylvester Taylor reported that the new president will be named on Monday, October 23.
- Senior Industrial Technology major, student Jaylen Burns was fatally shot on Sunday night. He was a native of Chicago, IL. Our prayers are with his family during this tragic time. Our condolences will be sent to the Chicago chapter to be sent to the family.

Secretary's Report:

The minutes from the September 2023 Chapter meeting were read silently by the
members. The recap was done by Secretary, Amethyst Whitley. The reporting was
based on Roberts Rules of Order, stating facts and voted on decisions. The motion was
made by Amethyst Whitley and seconded by Jerome Jones to accept the report with the
noted revisions.

Treasurer Report:

Dylester Scott reported that the September 2023 opening bank balance was \$15,120.33. September total income was \$3,957.81. Total expenses for September \$4,208.38. The September ending balance as of September 30th \$14,869.76. The JSUMAC Scholarship Fund available balance was \$2,173.50, restricted funds was \$700, and the adjusted total balance for the month of September was \$11,996.26. The Treasurer's Report for September was presented for information purposes only and subject to audit.

1st VP Committee Reports/ Updates

Richard Taylor reported on the Double Good Popcorn Fundraiser that will take place Tuesday, October 17 at 5 pm until Saturday, October 21 at 5 pm. Asking members to create pop-up shops to increase funds raised. The top 3 sellers will receive prizes that range from a full-page ad in the Jazz Brunch souvenir book, a year membership, and a gift card. Funds from this fundraiser will go towards student scholarships and student recruitment initiatives.

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 Amethyst Whitley reported that the monetary donations were used to purchase pantry items for the Student Pantry on campus. Upcoming community service projects include Toys for Tots and Meals on Wheels.

- Student Recruitment Fairs: We have upcoming college fairs that still require volunteers. Dates include Thursday, Nov 2 8:30 am-11:30 am at Stephenson High, Saturday Nov 4 at Langston High from 9 am-12 noon, and Friday, Nov 9 Mt. Zion High.
