POSSIBLE REFUND ON LAKE TAXES

UNDER A NEW MINNESOTA LAW, OWNERS OF SEASONAL/RECREATIONAL PROPERTY ON ANNANDALE AREA LAKES MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A PROPERTY TAX REFUND OF UP TO \$187.50.

THE REFUND IS INTENDED FOR THE OWNERS OF NON-HOMESTEAD PROPERTY WHOSE NET PROPERTY TAX INCREASED BY MORE THAN 10 PERCENT IN 1990. ITS INTENT IS TO PROVIDE FOR ONE YEAR A STATE-PAID REFUND OF 75 PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT, UP TO A MAXIMUM REFUND OF \$187.50.

MANY LAKESHORE PROPERTY OWNERS IN WRIGHT COUNTY EXPERIENCED TAX INCREASES OF 40 PERCENT OR MORE IN 1990, AND THE WRIGHT COUNTY FEDERATION OF LAKE ASSOCIATIONS HAS PLEDGED TO SEEK TAX RELIEF IN THE FUTURE YEARS. IN THE MEANTIME, THE REFUND CAN HELP TO ALLEVIATE THE SHOCK OF SOME OF THOSE HEFTY PROPERTY TAX INCREASES.

IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE REFUND, NON-HOMESTEAD PROPERTY OWNERS MUST COMPLETE THE PROPERTY TAX REFUND FORM (M-1PR) BEFORE AUGUST 15. TO BE ELIGIBLE, YOU MUST HAVE OWNED THE SAME SEASONAL RESIDENTIAL-RECREATIONAL PROPERTY ON JAN. 2, 1989 AND JAN. 2, 1990. THIS REFUND IS AVAILABLE REGARDLESS OF INCOME IN 1989. OWNERS OF SEASONAL/RECREATIONAL PROPERTY ARE ELIGIBLE EVEN IF THEY LIVE IN ANOTHER STATE OR ARE A LONG-TERM LEASEHOLDER ON THE PROPERTY.

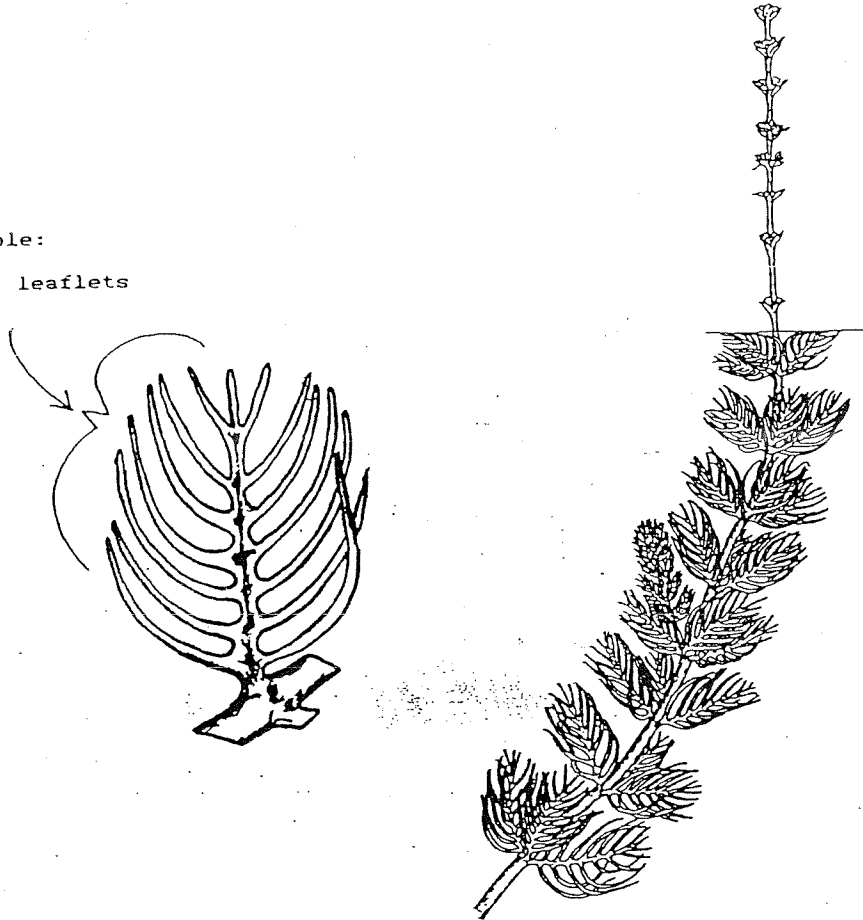
MILFOIL IS ON THE RISE

ENCLOSED ARE PICTURES OF BOTH EURASIAN WATER MILFOIL AND NORTHERN WATER MILFOIL, WHICH COULD BE VERY DAMAGING TO OUR LAKE. EVERY ONE SHOULD BE WATCHING FOR THIS POSSIBLE GROWTH IN THEIR AREA OF THE LAKE. ALL BOARD MEMBERS COULD HELP YOU IDENTIFY THE WEED IF YOU ARE UNSURE.

Example:

7 pair of leaflets



NORTHERN WATER MILFOIL
(*Myriophyllum exalbescens*)

1. 9 or fewer pairs of leaflets.
2. Coarser appearance than Eurasian and leaves do not collapse about the stem when removed from the water.
3. Stem rarely branches near the water surface.
4. Leaflets commonly more than 1.5 cm long.
5. Winter buds present in late fall through winter.

Example:

16 pair of leaflets



EURASIAN WATER MILFOIL
(*Myriophyllum spicatum*)

1. 9 or more pairs of leaflets.
2. Feathery appearance and leaves collapse about the stem when removed from the water.
3. Stem often branches near the water surface.
4. Leaflets rarely reach 1.5 cm in length.

Milfoil spreaders watch out -- penalties can be assessed

Boaters who spread water milfoil will face misdemeanor penalties under a bill passed by the 1990 legislature and signed into law May 11 by Gov. Rudy Perpich during the Governor's Fishing Opener activities in Hill City.

The new law was prompted by concern about the spread of Eurasian water milfoil, an exotic (non-native) aquatic plant that can hamper recreational activities on lakes. It also shades out native vegetation valuable to fish as habitat.

Eurasian water milfoil was first found in North American waters in the 1940s. Since then, it has spread into at least 57 states and two Canadian provinces. It was first discovered in Minnesota at Lake Minnetonka in 1987 and has al-

ready been identified in 22 Minnesota lakes.

The plant's main method of reproduction is by fragmentation. Even small fragments of the plant transported between bodies of water can regenerate into new plants, thus spreading the infestation. Boaters should remove vegetation from all parts of their boats and trailers at accesses before launching and again before leaving.

Boaters who fail to follow the above recommendations may be guilty of a misdemeanor. The new law prohibits the transportation of Eurasian water milfoil or Northern water milfoil on roads or highways. It also prohibits the launching of a boat with either weed attached. (Although Northern water milfoil is not a problem weed, it is included in the restrictions because it



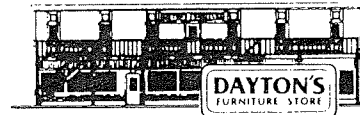

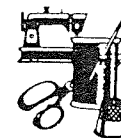
