






DNR SURVEYED CEDAR LAKE

July 8 - 12 the lake was surveyed. They stayed at Geardink's Resort. Ella tols us a thorough report will be published next March. They put out "Gill" nets and "Trap" nets. They found a Carp, 1 Bullhead, Bass and Crappies. They were only looking for small fish, mostly Sun Fish. We have 4 species of Sun Fish in our lake. Pumpkin Seed", "Sunnies", "Blue Gills' and "Hybrid Sun Fish". The description is like a regular "Sunny", however, there is a white line through the fins.

The Biologist told Ella that because of the quality of the lake, it is unlikely that we will have any "Milfoil" problems. However, we must continue to be alert and keep up our search.

They also surveyed Lake Sylvia, Marie, and Louise in Wright County.

If we can get a copy of the survey report, we will publish it next spring.

DNR urges new approach to lakeshore landscaping

Manicured bluegrass to the water's edge and a sandy swimming beach seem ideal to many lakeshore owners, but this landscape has liabilities. The grass requires constant mowing and treatment with fertilizers and herbicides that wash into the lake. Geese and ducks are attracted to the short grass and sandy shore where they graze, or loaf and defecate until the area is unfit for human use.

Nongame Wildlife Supervisor Carrol Henderson has a better idea. It's called lakescaping for wildlife, a landscape design that saves labor, reduces the need for fertilizer, and uses native plants to create beauty while accommodating the diverse needs of people and wildlife. Call Henderson at (612) 296-0700 for a story about lakescaping.
