If you read the May issue of the newsletter, you know that Milfoil is all around us. Let's hope that next year when we do the search again, that we will have another good report.

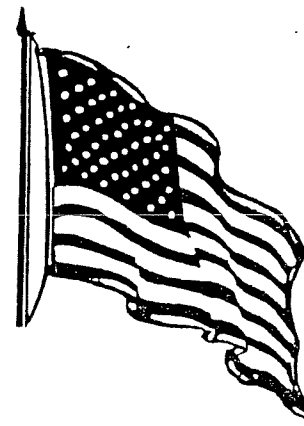
Remember! We are all responsible for checking our boat and trailer for any weeds that cling to the vehicles. Don't throw any weeds back into the lake!

New Year's Day, January 1

 Easter Sunday, (variable)
 Army Day, April 6

COLOR MEANINGS:

REDstands for hardiness and courage.
 WHITE ...is the symbol of purity and innocence.
 BLUEis the color vigilance, perseverance and justice.

WHEN AND WHERE TO DISPLAY THE FLAG

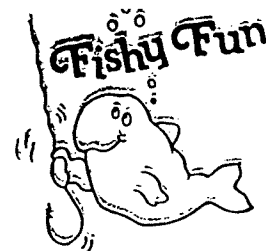
On buildings and stationary flagpoles outdoors, the flag should be displayed only from sunrise to sunset. It should not be displayed at all during stormy or rainy weather, unless for some very special reason.

In no case should it ever touch the ground. It should be raised with hearty briskness, and when lowered, it should be done solemnly and slowly.

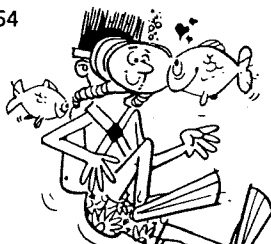

MINNESOTA BOATING GUIDE - laws and regulations

The following information is taken from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources regarding the rules and regulations about operating watercraft on the state's lakes and rivers. To obtain a copy you can write to Boat and Water Safety Section; Minnesota Department of Natural Resources; 500 Lafayette Road; St. Paul, Mn. 55155.

MOTORBOAT OPERATOR AGE RESTRICTIONS:

<u>Operator Age</u>	<u>Restrictions (1/1/97)</u>
Less than 12	-1- 25hp or less - no restriction -2- More than 25 thru 75 hp - MUST have someone at least 21 within reach of the controls. -3- Over 75hp - CANNOT operate, even with an adult on board.
-----	-----
12-17 years of age	-1- 25hp or less - no restriction -2- Over 25 hp - must either have: *a watercraft operator's permit, or *Someone at least 21 on board within reach of the controls.

GENERAL PROHIBITIONS

It's against the law:

- *To operate a watercraft in a careless manner.
- *To operate a watercraft so that its wake or wash interferes with any person or property.
- *To operate a watercraft within an area marked-off for swimming or within 150 feet of a diver's warning flag.
- *To operate a watercraft loaded with passengers or cargo beyond its safe carrying capacity.
- *To deposit or leave refuse in or upon the water or public access area.

PERSONAL WATERCRAFT LAWS

Sometimes known as Jet Skiis, Wet Skiis, Wave Runners, Sea Doos, Water Scooters etc.

(Personal Watercraft Laws cont.)

- *Anyone driving or riding must be wearing an approved life jacket.
- *You may NOT operate a personal watercraft between sunset and 8:00 a.m. the following day.
- *You may NOT travel at greater speed than a slow - no wake speed, within a 100 feet of any shoreline, dock, swimmer, swimming raft, any moored or anchored watercraft at any time. (slow - no wake is the slowest possible speed to maintain steerage, but in NO case greater than five miles per hour)
- *If you have a person on water skiis or any other device, there must be an additional person on board. (Factory installed or factory specified wide field rearview mirrors are allowed)
- *If the machine is equipped with a lanyard-type engine cutoff switch, it must be attached to the person, life jacket, or clothing of the operator.
- *You may not chase or harass wildlife.
- *You may not travel through emergent or floating vegetation at greater than slow - no wake speed.
- *You may not operate a personal watercraft in a manner that unreasonably or unnecessarily endangers life, limb, or property.
- *You may not weave through congested watercraft traffic, or jump the wake of another watercraft within 100 feet of the other watercraft
- **A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 13 YEARS MAY NOT OPERATE A PERSONAL WATERCRAFT EVEN WITH AN ADULT ON BOARD.
- *A person 13 - 17 may operate a personal watercraft without a watercraft operator's permit if an adult accompanies them on the craft.
- **Watercraft operator permits are available from the DNR. Please contact them for more information
- *Personal watercraft may not exceed the maximum noise levels.
- *It is unlawful to operate a personal watercraft while intoxicated.

With the fast growing popularity of personal watercraft there is also growing numbers of complaints and accidents. We must remember to ride with pride and use sound judgment. Be a good neighbor and enjoy the summer.
