### LAKE SURVEY REPORT

#### MINNESOTA ADEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES Section of Fisheries

The following information is excerpts from a report made last July,1996. If you are interested in reading the full report, please see Ella Geardink. The group for the DNR stayed at her resort while studying the lake. Previous surveys and investigations were done in 1980, 1986, 1991 and 1996.

CEDAR LAKE is in Wright County. The nearest town is Annandale or Maple Lake. Located in Croinna Township. The Lake Area is 837 acres and the maximum depth is 108 feet.

During mid-July adequate dissolved oxygen is present down to 21 feet. The public access for Cedar Lake is located in the northwest corner of County Road 6.

CEDAR LAKE is located within 50 miles of the Twin Cities Metropolitan area. Due to its location and the presence of the county campground, Cedar Lake receives heavy fishing pressure for a lake of its size. Black crappie, bluegill, walleye, largemouth bass and northern pike are all present in the lake. In the summer of 1996, a lake survey was conducted on Cedar Lake. The netting of the lake revealed the following information about the fish population.

The northern pike catcherate in gill nets (19.8/gill net) significantly increased from the last survey (5.9/gill net). This catch rate of northern pike was above expected levels or lakes that are similar to Cedar Lake. The average size norhern caught in gill nets weighed 2.3 pounds and was 21.6 inches long. The growth rate of northern pike was average when compared with other lakes. During the spring ice-out assessment, a total of 157 northern pike were marked with a fin clip. During the summer survey, a total of 158 norhern pike were caught, of which I was marked from the spring survey. By using the ratio of marked to unmarked fish, a population estimate of 12,561 northern pike in Cedar Lake (15.0 northern pike/acre) was made.

The gill net catch rate of yellow perch in Cedar Lake (0.3/gill net) significantly declined from the last survey (10.0/gill net) and fell below expected levels for this lake type. The decline in perch numbers may be attributed to the increase in northern pike catch, as yellow perch are an important part of their diet. The average size yellow perch caught in gill nets was 5.8 inches in length and 0.1 lbs. in weight. The growth rate of yellow perch in Cedar Lake was average.

Lake Survey Report, Continued.

The gill net catch rate of walleye in Cedar Lake (4.5/gill net) significantly increased from the last survey (1.4gill net) but remained within levels for this lake type. Historically, the catch of walleye in Cedar Lake has been variable, ranging from 1.4 to 9.3 per gill net. The average size walleye caught in gill nets was 18.7 inches long and weighed 2.4 lbs. The vast majority of walleye caught came from years when walleye were stocked. The growth rate of walleye was average compared with other lakes that are similar to Cedar. A population estimate for walleye was made during the 1996 lake survey. During the spring iceout assessment, a total of 179 walleye were marked with a fin clip. During the summer survey, a total of 36 walleye were caught, of which 2 had been marked during the spring survey. By using the ratio of marked to unmarked fish, a population estimate of 2,200 walleye in Cedar Lake (2.7 walleye/acre) was made.

The trap net catch of bluegills in Cedar Lake (20.5/trap net) appeared to decline slightly from the previous netting in 1990 (45.4/trap net) and remained within normal levels for this lake type.

Bluegill caught in trap nets ranged in size from 2.3-8.4 inches and averaged 4.5 inches in length. The growth rate of bluegills in Cedar Lake was average.

The largemouth bass were sam pled by spring electrofishing. A total of 33 bass were sampled at a rate of 19.8 per hour of run-time. The catch rate was slightly above the lake class 24 median (16.0 bass per hour shocked) for the Montrose Area. Largemouth bass sampled ranged in size from 7.7-16.8 inches and average 12.5 inches in length. The mean weight of bass caught was 1.2 lbs. The growth rate of largemouth bass was average.

We should be proud of our lake. It is clean, no pollution was found, and it seems that we have the fish that we need to make us all happy. Remember, if you want to read more statistics, just stop at the resort, on the north end of the lake, and Ella Geardink will help you.


