

General Field Rules

- 1. Be a member or guest of a member in good standing of the Club before flying from the field or using any of the facilities. For insurance purposes.
- 2. Be a member in good standing of MAAC and abide by MAAC rules and regulations and comply with the safety code in order to obtain liability coverage in case of a claim.
- 3. All members will conduct themselves in a manner which is courteous and considerate of others on the field/s at any time.
- 4. No liquor to be consumed before or while engaged in flying or other R/C activities.
- 5. When piloting an aircraft:
 - a. The frequency board must be used when using radios with frequencies older than 1991.
 - b. Pilots are responsible for pre-flight checks.
 - c. Prop blast from engines running in pit area must not be directed at persons or other aircraft.
 - d. No take-off is allowed directly from the pit area.
 - e. Initial turn after take-off must be away from pit areas.
 - f. No high speed passes shall be closer than 50 feet from pit area.
 - g. No flying over or behind pit area or outbuildings. Approved airspace is to the east of the pit area and clubhouse.
 - h. Flying is not allowed while the field is being maintained.
 - i. All engines larger than .15 c.i. shall have a muffler.
 - j. MAAC "Wings" flight training Level "A" must be attained before a pilot can fly unassisted.
- 6. A spotter is necessary
 - a. when piloting your aircraft if there is more than one aircraft either in motion on the field or in the airspace.
 - b. when more than two R/C trucks or cars are in motion on the track.
- 7. No pets allowed on any of the field areas and must be on a leash.
- The last member leaving the facility grounds shall ensure the security of the field and clubhouse by locking the clubhouse and the field gate.
