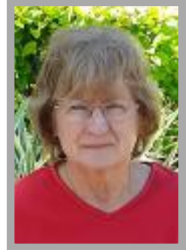

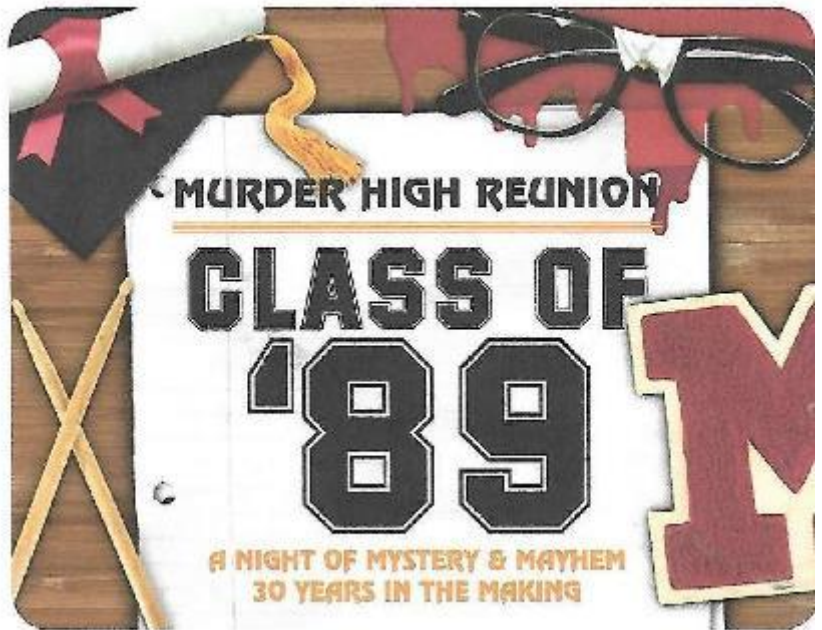
TERRY JOHNSON- Hall Monitor. Terry was hard-nosed in school and even more so now that he is a traffic cop.

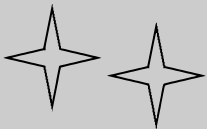
