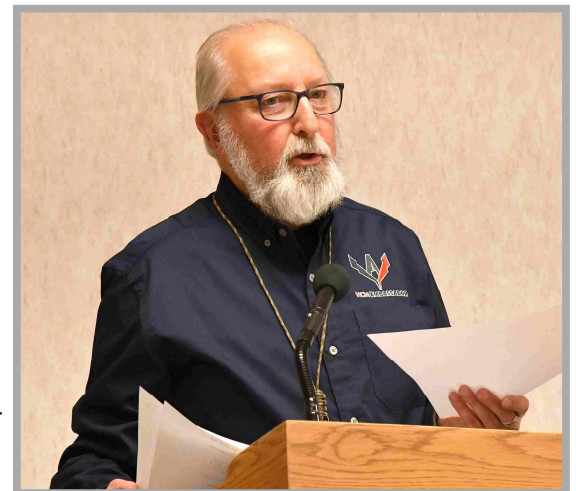
FROM THE PRESIDENT

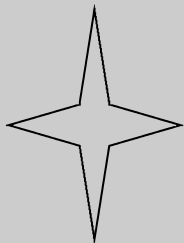
