JANUARY CLUB MEETINGS

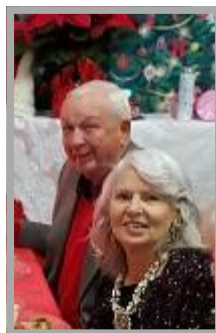
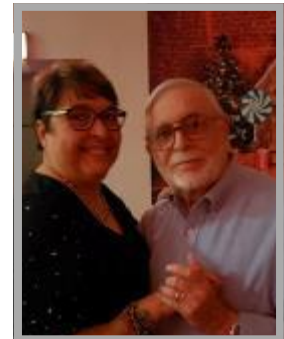
