The Corvette Assembly Plant is offering tours to watch the C8 Corvettes being built on the assembly line. Tickets can be ordered on-line at the National Corvette Museum website and should be booked in advance. The tours are not available on weekends and certain blackout dates. Must be 13 years or older, no cameras, phones, electronic devices. Must wear closed toe, closed heel shoes. No walking assist, such as canes, walkers nor crutches.

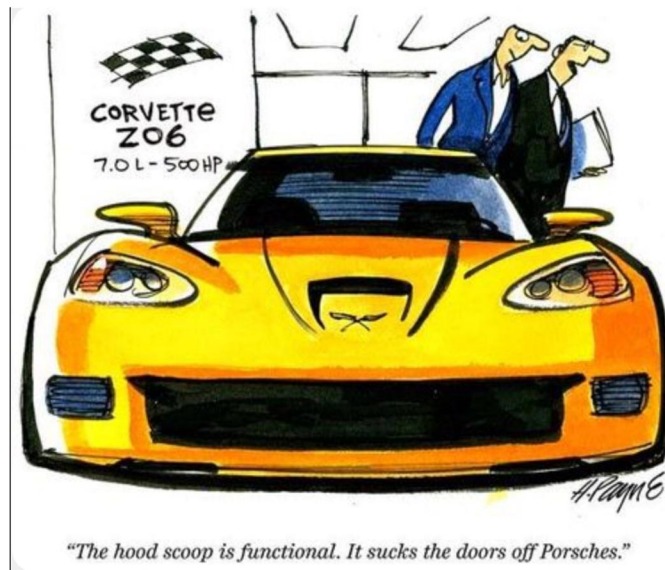
The Michelin Bash will be held April 27 – 29. The event includes seminars by Michelin, Mobil 1, Corvette Engineering Team, Bowling Green Assembly Plant, guided road tours to local attractions, vendors and a live auction. Corvette Engineers typically discuss current C8 production specs and may release future C8 options.

The Motorsports Park now has a fleet of the new Z06 Corvettes to offer you a driving experience. Test the power and performance of this amazing vehicle by driving four laps around the 3.2 mile, 23 turn road course. Pre-booking is strongly encouraged.
