The BP HOA Board and Security Committee has compiled the following information for the members regarding local contacts for law enforcement. Regardless of information or recommendations shared, if any property owner ever has questions regarding their private property or sees illegal activity anywhere, they should contact local law enforcement in accordance with local laws. The information below is for reference.

If someone sees possible illegal activity:

-on public waters by a boater and wants to report it, they should call **NC Wildlife at 1-800-662-7137.**

-on land (non-emergency) whether on private or HOA owned property and wants to report it, they should call the **Beaufort County Sheriff's Office at 252-946-7111**

-FOR ANY AND ALL EMERGENCY SITUATIONS, CALL 911

It is not necessary to call law enforcement if you see someone **you** don't know on one of the beaches in our subdivision. All owners should enforce trespassing laws on their private property since they are the only ones that know who has permission to be there. We will be installing new "Private Property/No Trespassing" signs on the high traffic beach areas to deter trespassing. All owners being consistent as a group on monitoring and enforcing laws correctly will help Beaufort Point be a safe place for all of us. We appreciate everyone's participation and desire to keep our community a safe place for all of us.
