

A MESSAGE FROM TOBIAS ELLIS

Happy feast of the Ascension!

As the academic year is about to end, I have been reflecting on the many graces with which God has blessed me over the past couple semesters. I am grateful for so many things, most especially the opportunity to be in the Pierz area with you every month. It has been a joy to get to know you and to spend time in the community learning about life in a parish. This summer I will continue to live at the Saint Paul Seminary while serving as a hospital chaplain at the Hennepin County Medical Center. In August, I have a couple retreats scheduled and then some time at home before I return in the fall to start my second year of theological studies. It is hard to believe that in around two to three short years I will be ordained a deacon. The Lord has done so much in my life over the past year, and I cannot wait to see what He has in store over the next few!

Before He ascends to the Father, the gospel for this Sunday features Jesus giving His apostles the power to drive out demons and bring healing to the sick. Then, He sends His disciples on mission to evangelize the world. As I am in formation for priestly ministry, it is very exciting that I might do the very same deeds in Jesus' name, but yet all too easy to doubt whether I will have faith that strong, or if God will give me all the gifts I need. Of course, such thoughts are not from God, and I have found the Scripture passage of John 13 very comforting. At the Last Supper, John rests his head on Jesus' heart. Later, John is the only disciple at the foot of the cross when Our Lord breathes His last. It cannot be a coincidence that the one and the same apostle who was close to the foot of the cross was also close to the heart of Christ.

This summer I will visit many who are suffering, and all of us are hurting in different ways. However, I keep returning to the apostle John and how he found courage in his sorrow by staying close to Jesus. This year I have been convicted that whether in Eucharistic adoration or in moments of quiet at home, Jesus invites us to be present to Him in prayer, and He wants to fill us to overflowing with His gifts and grace. Let us never underestimate the power of prayer, and continue to strengthen each other with our prayers, this summer and beyond!



- -Collaboration with the pastor and staff on daily operation, evangelism and general planning for the parishes.


