TIFTON ELKS LODGE 1114 POOL RULES

Rules are in place to provide a safe and enjoyable pool experience for all members, their families, and their guests.

Families and guests are expected to abide by all rules. The Elks Member is responsible they abide and know rules.

Violation of rules may constitute a warning, suspension, or forfeiture of membership.

Pool is open 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM daily.

NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

The TIKI Hut can be reserved by members for no charge. Reservation must be made two weeks in advance and is limited to two hours. Southern Caterers can also reserve the TIKI Hut. They are required a two week notice and are also limited to two hours. Members are not limited from the pool at any time but are asked to respect reservations.

RULES

- 1. Only members in good standing (current dues) can use the pool and surrounding areas.
- 2. A member or family member (over 16 years old) must be present with guests.
- 3. No solo swimming.
- 4. All swimmers under 16-years-old must be accompanied by an adult.
- 5. NO GLASS IN POOL AREA. Violators will receive an immediate 30-day suspension from the pool.
- 6. Members can invite up to four guest sat one time.
- 7. Local guests are allowed four visits before becoming a member.
- 8. No open sores allowed in the pool
- 9. No running, diving, or horseplay.
- 10. No food in the pool.
- 11. No vulgar language, profanity, or hate speech.
- 12. Fighting and throwing food or drinks will result in pool suspension for the season. Expulsion from the Lodge is a consideration.
- 13. Smoking or Vaping is allowed only in the covered and carpeted area and on the grass on he hill beneath the pool area.
- 14. Excessive alcohol consumption is discouraged and intoxicated people may be asked to leave the premises.
- 15. Remove all pool toys from the pool area and store them properly before you leave. Abandoned toys will be discarded.
- 16. Place all trash in proper receptacles.
