Health Guarantee

We advise that the puppy stay clear of public areas until the puppy has had all its vaccinations to insure immunity against diseases.

Your puppy is guaranteed for its first year of life (to be replaced by the breeder with a like puppy or a full refund) against life-threatening genetic defects. If the puppy develops a life-threatening illness before they are a year old, the purchaser may be eligible for a replacement puppy, pending availability, or a full refund at the discretion of the breeder. An official autopsy/veterinarian's report must be given to the breeder for eligibility of replacing a puppy (or a full refund); if not, this guarantee will be null and void. All veterinarian charges are the sole responsibility of the purchaser and will under NO circumstances be paid by the breeder.

If the puppy should die to a congenital/hereditary defect within its first year of life, the breeder will choose to place the puppy with another puppy or a full refund within a timely manner. This decision is completely up to the breeder. The breeder must receive a COMPLETE AUTOPSY REPORT completed by a licensed veterinarian and will be done at the purchaser's expense, stating the cause of death.

The breeder is not responsible for the death or illness due to hypoglycemia (low blood sugar). It can be caused by several reasons including, but not limited to, poor nutrition, being handled too much, and the stress induced by traveling. Hypoglycemia is more common in smaller teacup puppies. It is the responsibility of the purchaser to ensure proper nutrition and care for the puppy.

The breeder guarantees the completion of all age-appropriate vaccinations and dewormings before the puppy is released to the new owner. Parvovirus is not covered in this health guarantee. The new owner should use caution when taking the puppy in public places/high traffic areas until the puppy has had its third, and final, vaccine. The breeder will not warranty the puppy against any adverse reactions to future vaccinations/medications.

Puppies are also susceptible to pneumonia, colds, and other infections due to viruses, cold temperatures, etc. Ear mites, fleas, ticks, worms, giardia, and coccidian parasites are not serious health problems and are excluded from this guarantee. The breeder does not guarantee against any worms or coccidian parasites. These conditions are all the purchaser's responsibility.

If purchaser is unable to keep the puppy for other reasons not covered under this guarantee, the puppy will be returned to the breeder. A refund may be offered at the discretion of the breeder and is not guaranteed.

This health guarantee is void if the puppy is not up to date on all age-appropriate shots after purchase. Proof of vaccines must be provided.

Any legal action which may arise regarding the terms of this contract will be processed in Tift County, Georgia. The laws in the state of Georgia will be controlling.

PUPPYS' WEIGHTS ARE ESTIMATED BASED ON PUPPY CHARTS AND ARE CONSIDERED OUR BEST GUESS, NOT A GUARANTEED NUMBER. I DO NOT GUARANTEE THAT THE PUPPY'S EARS WILL REMAIN STANDING OR THE COLOR OF THE PUPPY'S COAT. CHANGES IN COLOR OF THE PUPPY'S COAT AND EARS ABILITY TO STAND ARE NOT UNCOMMON AS THE PUPPY AGES.

HEALTH PROBLEMS THAT CAN BE CURED BY MEDICATION/SURGERY ARE NOT COVERED. THIS GUARANTEE IS NONTRANSFERABLE. ALL PUPPIES ARE SOLD AS PETS. NO GUARANTEE IS MADE TO DISPOSITION, CONFORMATION, SIZE, OR BREEDING ABILITY.
