MUSIC NOTES

Our sequence hymn "Lord, make us servants of your peace" is attributed to the Prayer of St. Francis. James Quinn framed these words for music. Quinn was a Scottish Jesuit and a prolific hymnist, whose work was published in English language hymnals of nearly every denomination. He contributed to five hymns in our hymnal. The melody for this hymn was composed by Lee Hasting Bristol, Jr., the grandson of the founder of Bristol-Myers Company. A former president of Westminster Choir College, Bristol was a member of the Episcopal Church Joint Commission on Church Music. A graduate of Hamilton College, he also earned a Licentiate in organ from Trinity College of Music, London. A noted speaker and preacher, he spoke at Westminster Cathedral four times. Bristol wrote numerous choral and organ compositions. This tune, *Dickinson College*, is used twice in our hymnal.
