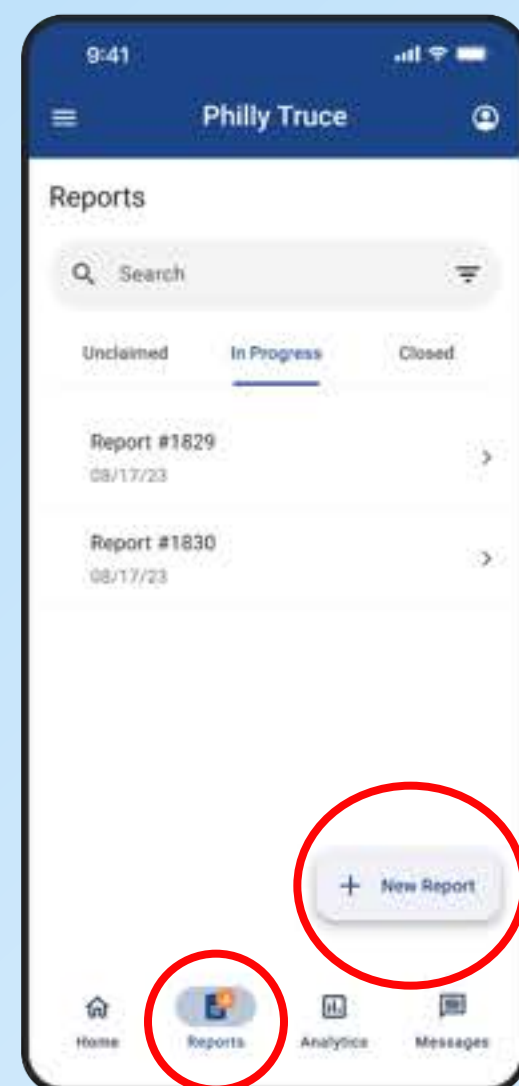
SPM can edit key details in the initial report

SPM can link a single report to multiple reports

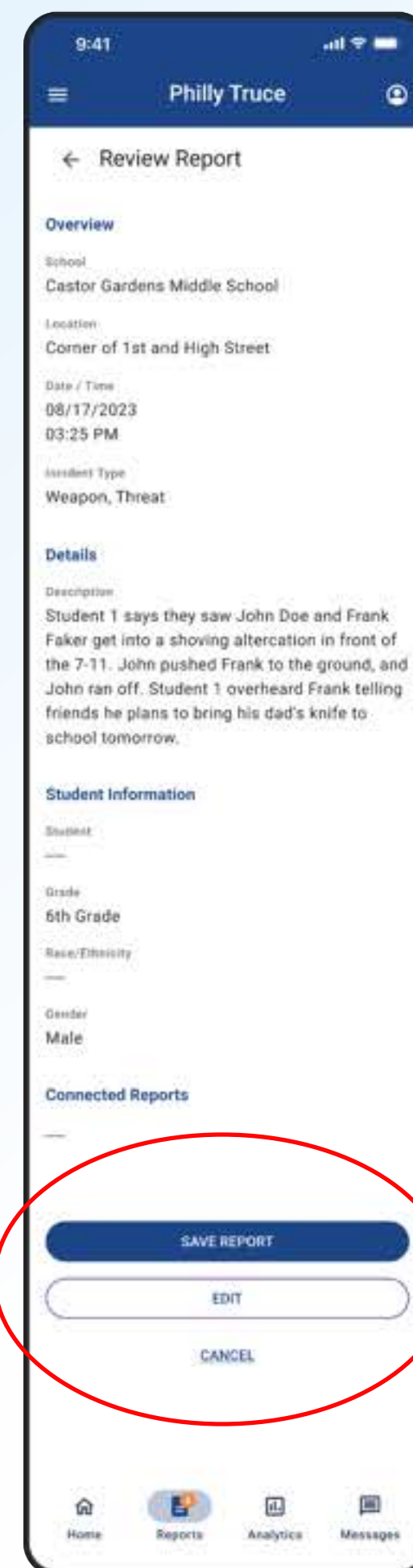
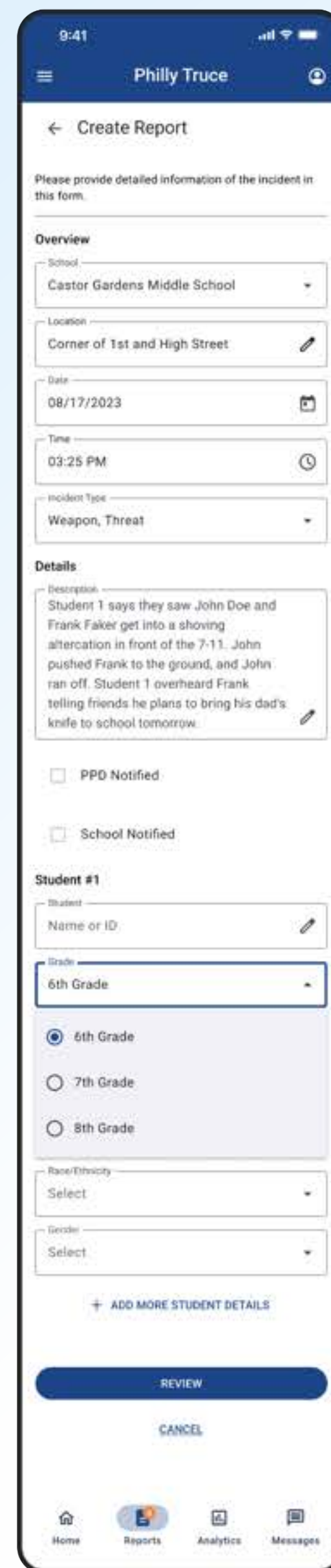
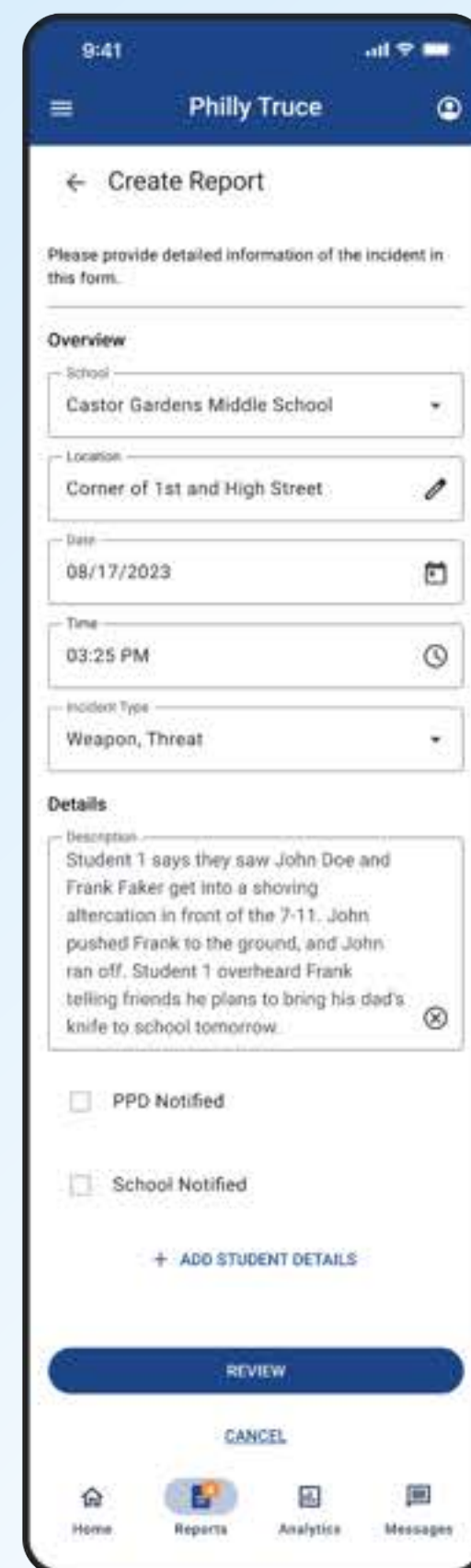
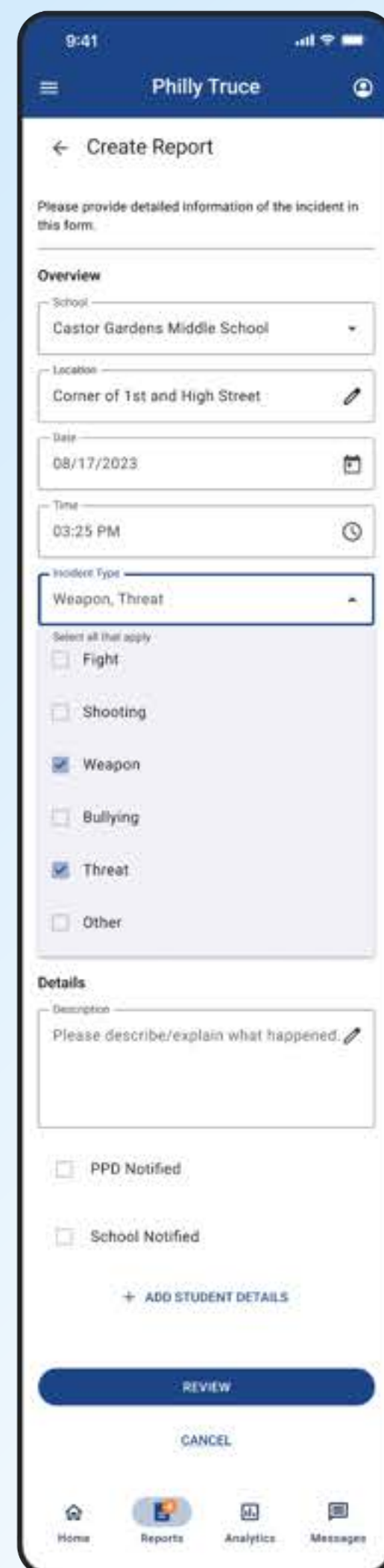
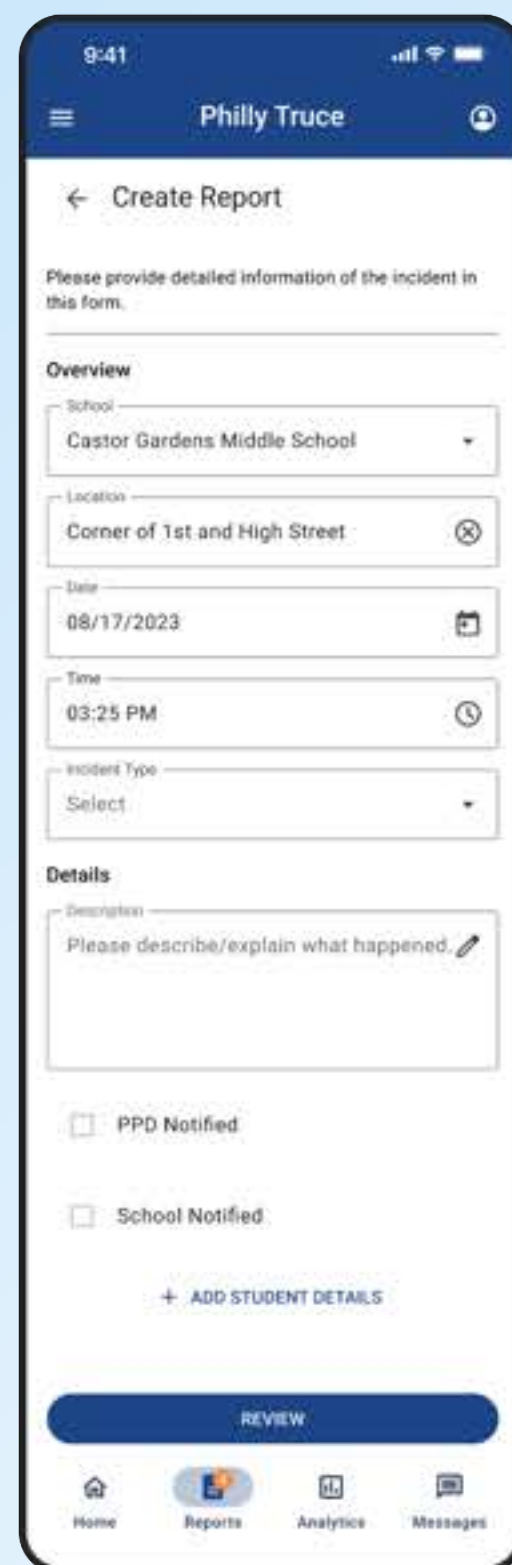
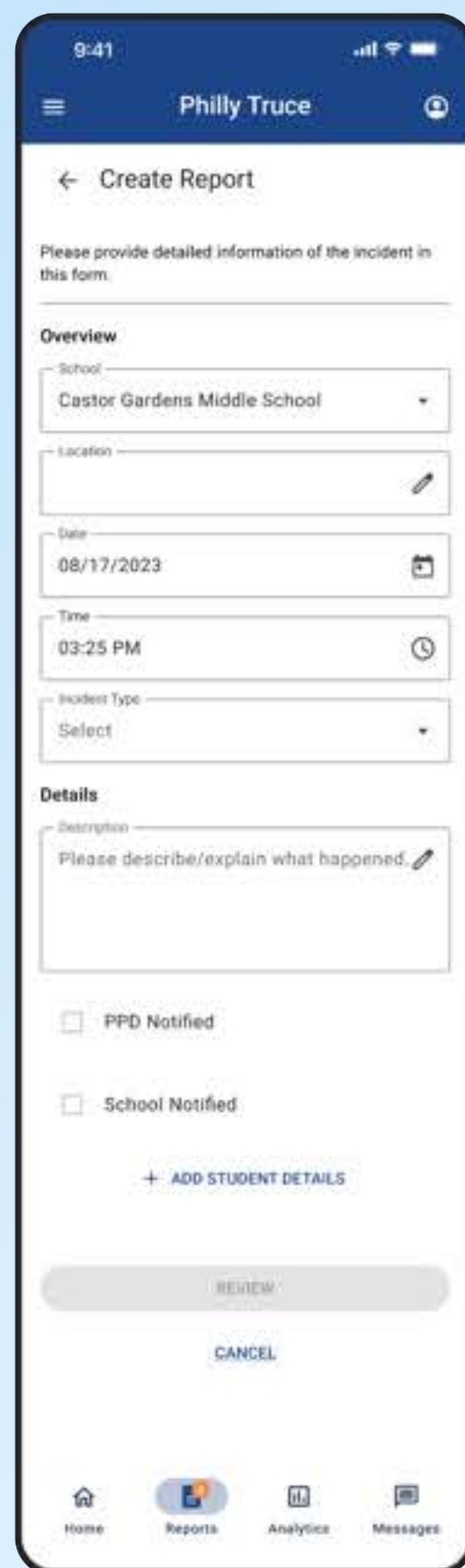
Steps:

- SPM edits keys details in initial report and can link initial report to other reports that might be involved in a given incident.

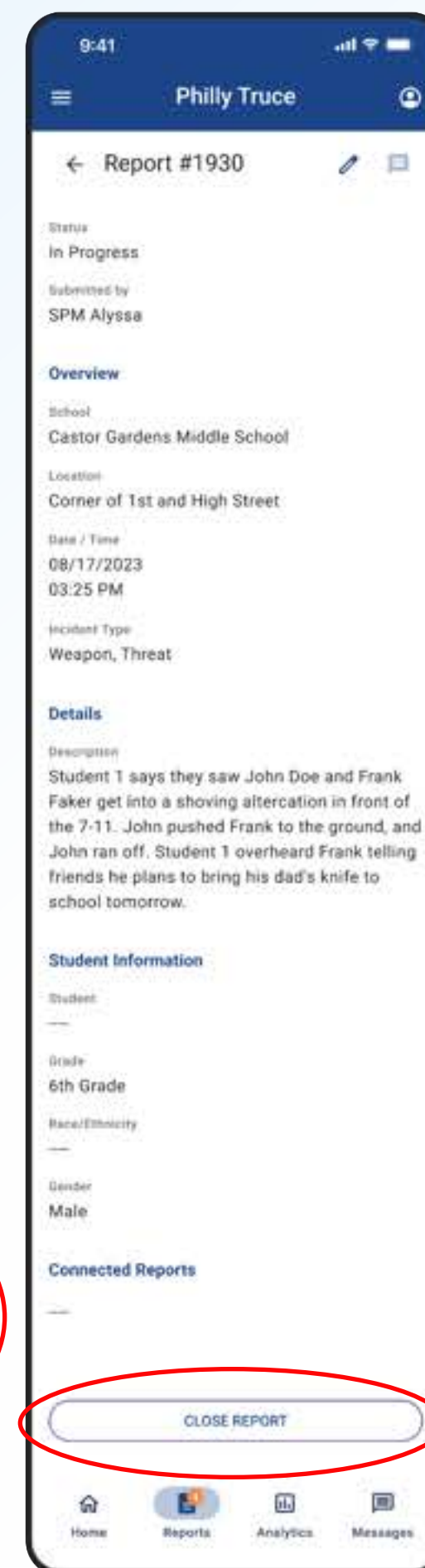
New Report

Information entered is saved in the report. Information the monitor chooses to omit will be represented with a line dash.



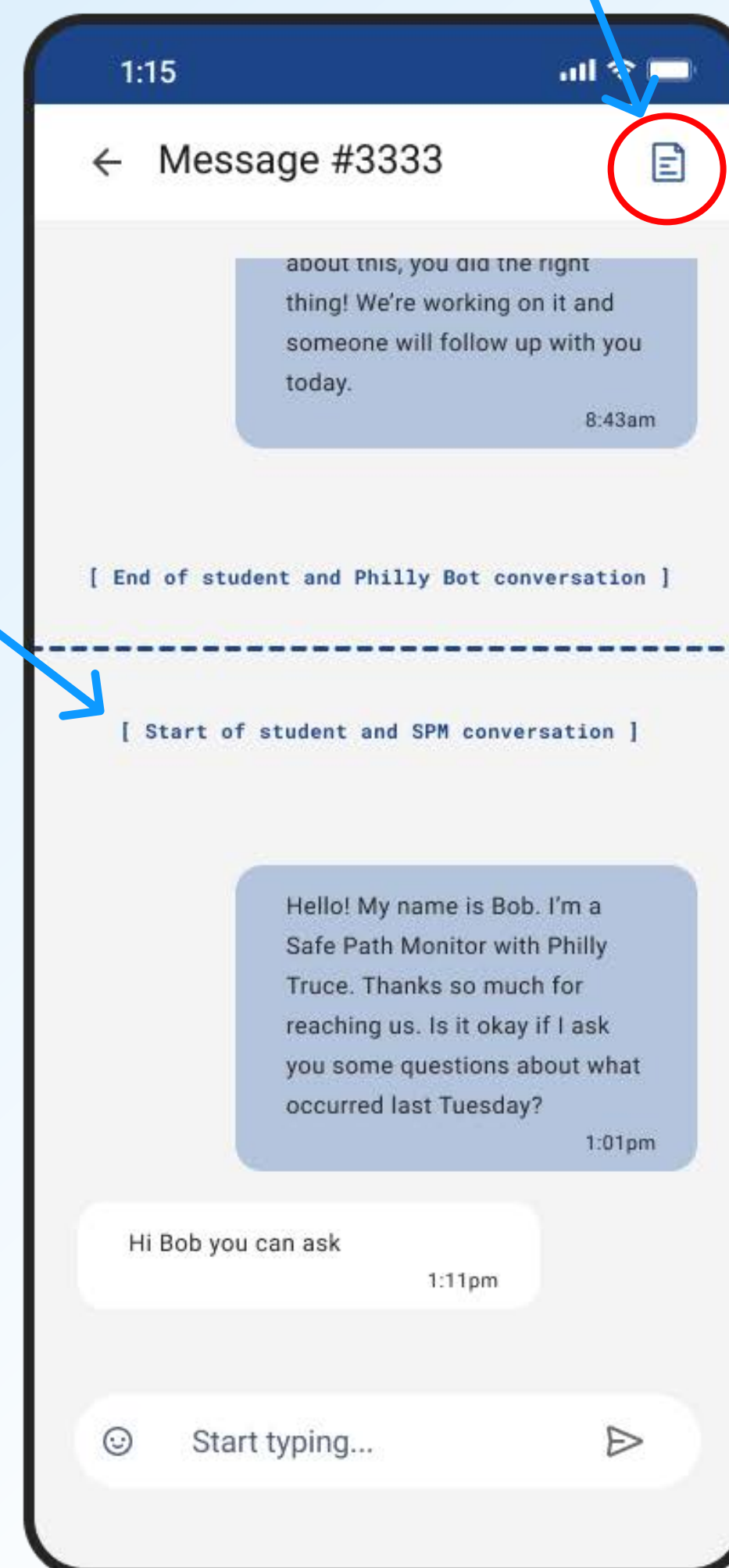
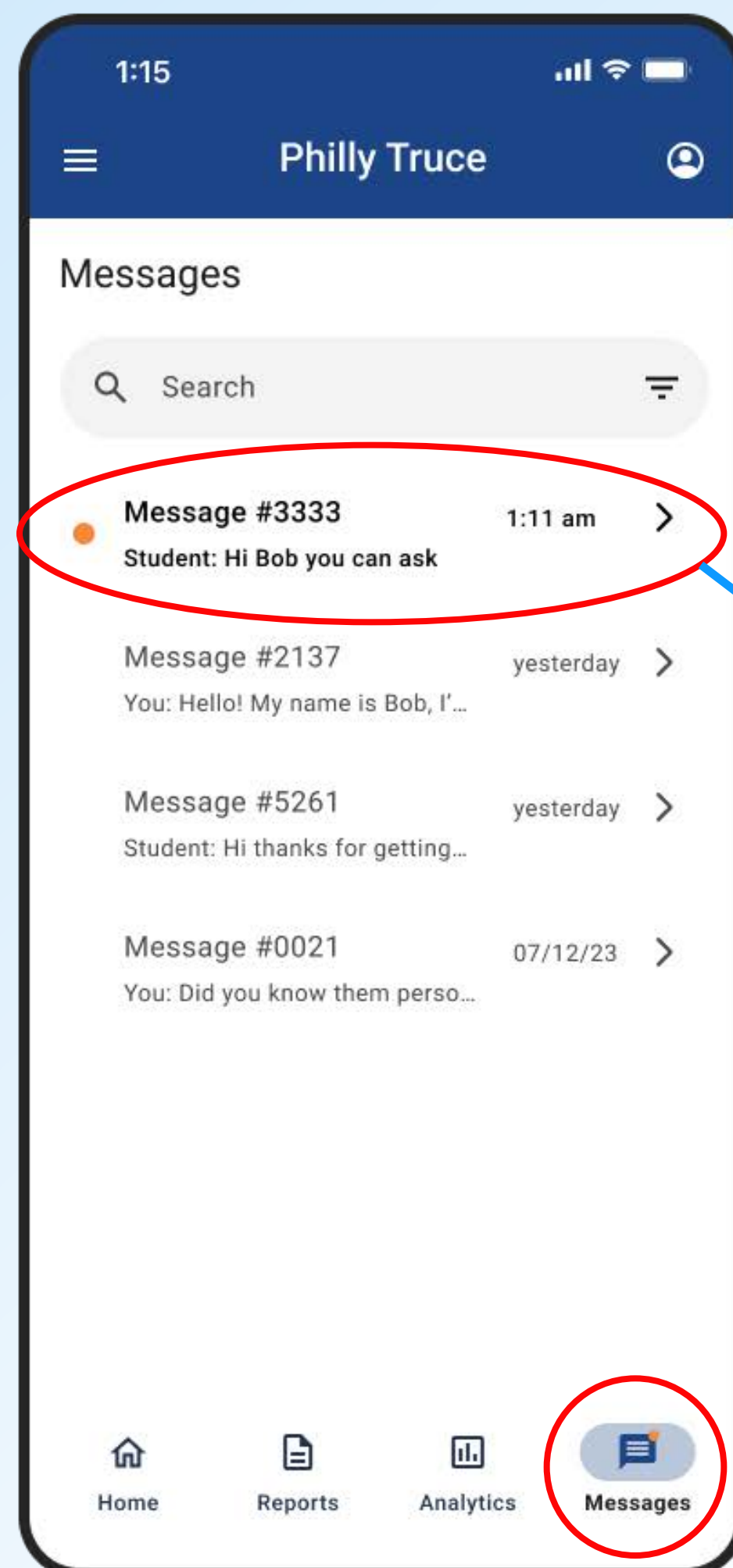
Last step is to "close" report for school district administrators to review.

SPM can now complete a new report by filling in key details.

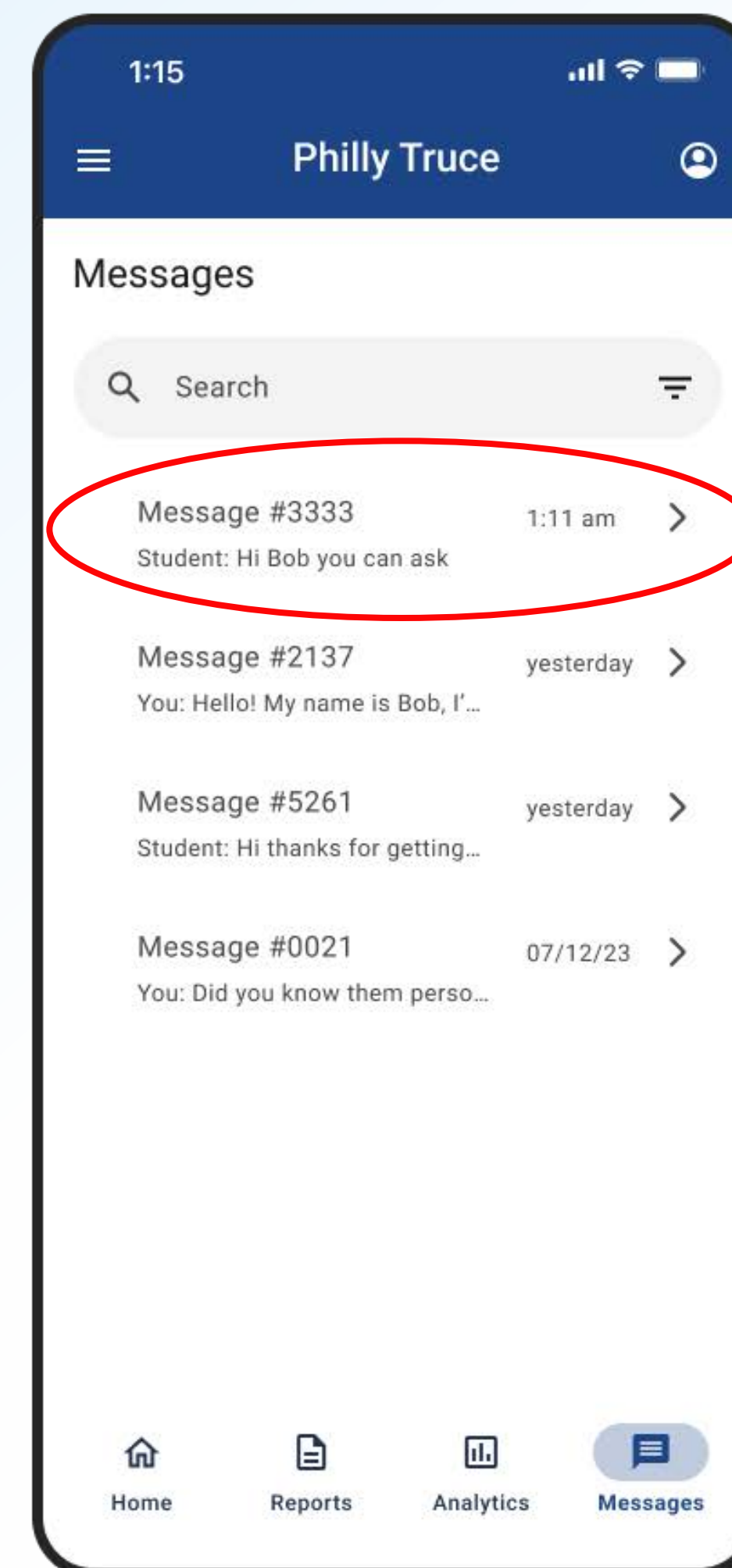
Students details can also be entered here if they are witnessing an incident in real life.

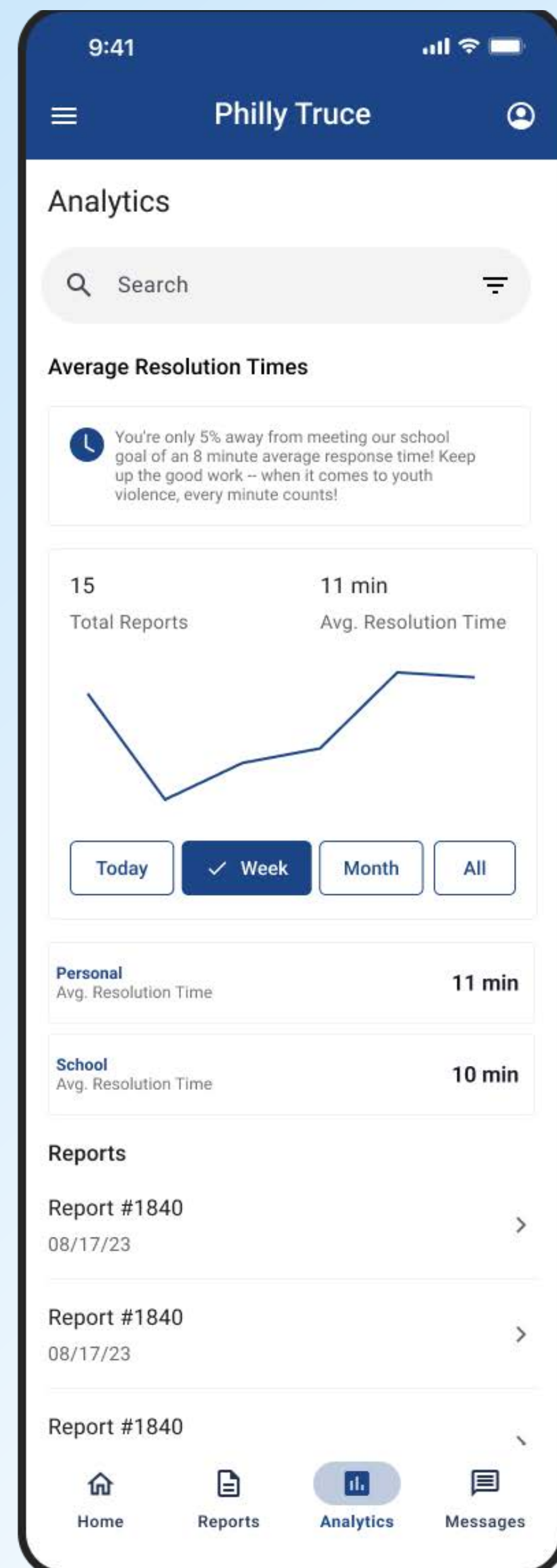
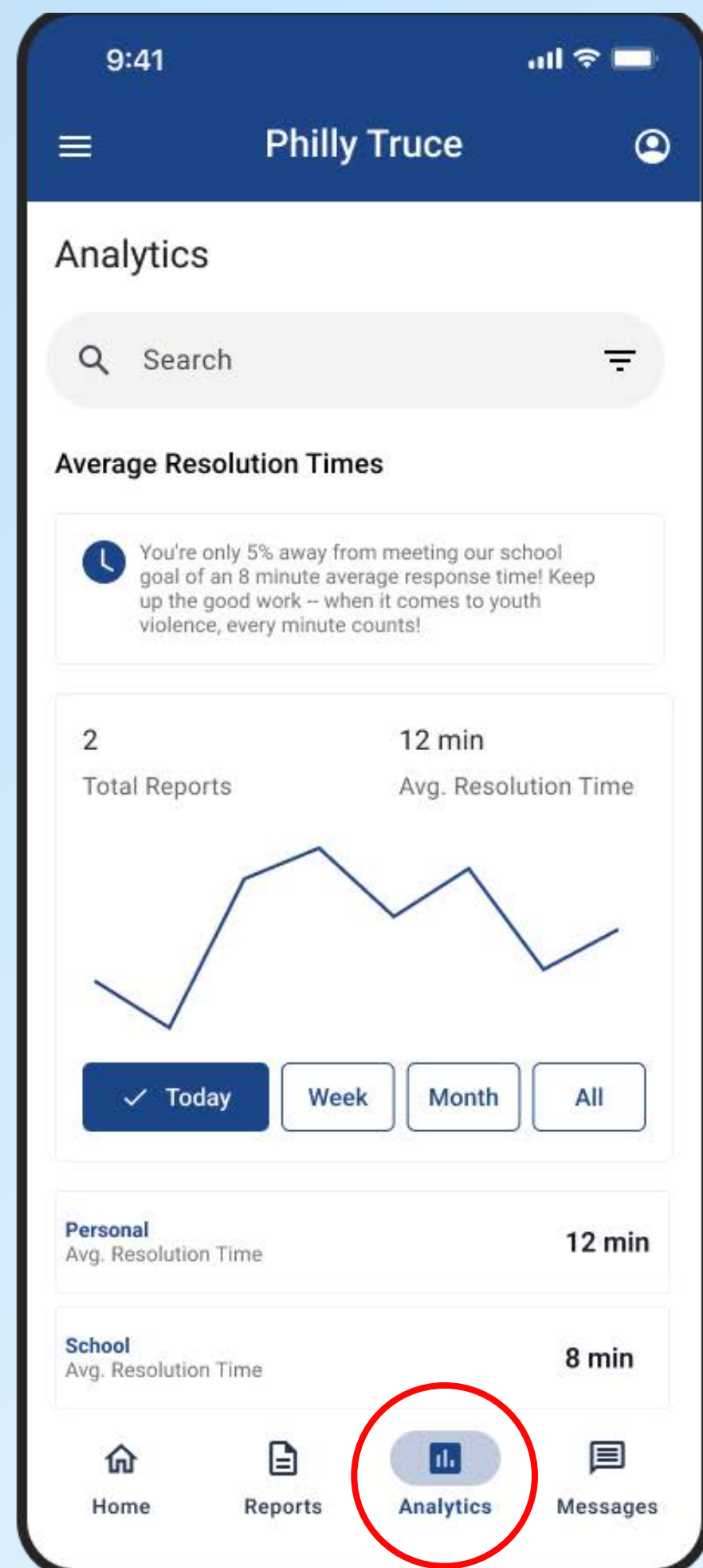
Steps:

- SPM taps messages icon from nav bar.
- Red notification alert shows SPMs when a new message is coming in.
- A chat bot would have been interacting with student prior to SPM messaging to get general information (i.e location, school, grade, etc.). All of other information is anonymous unless student decided to disclose it.



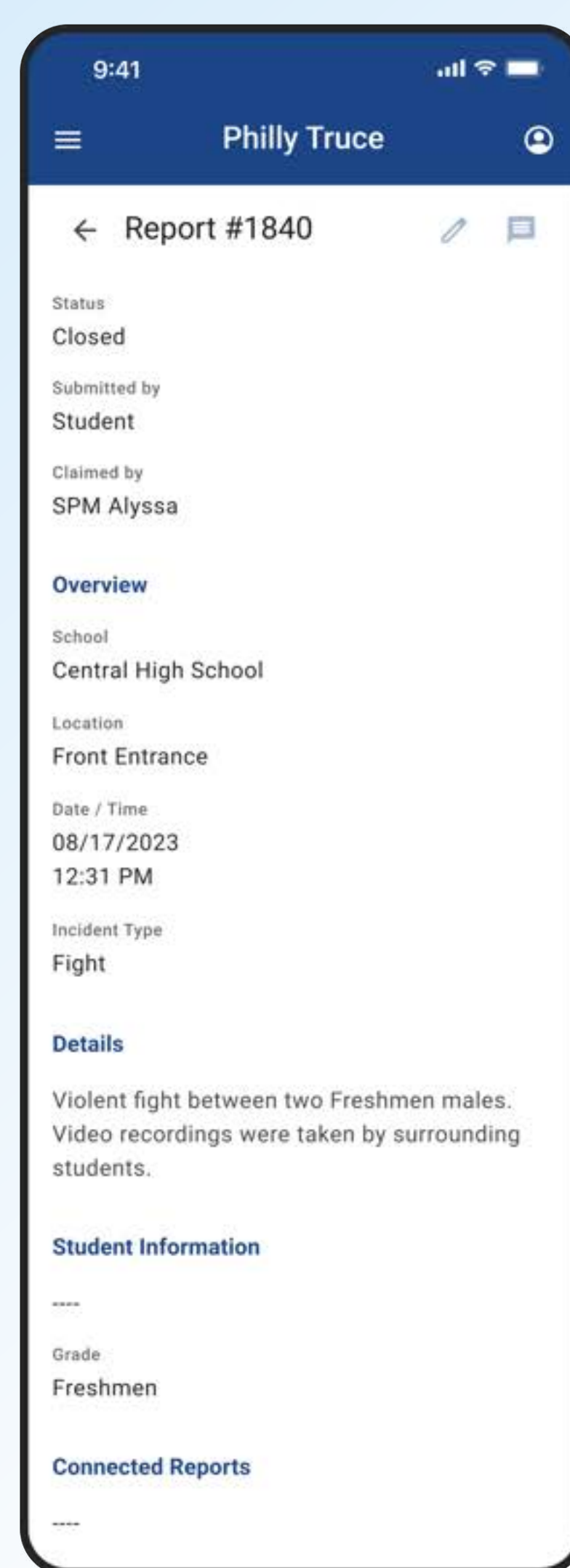
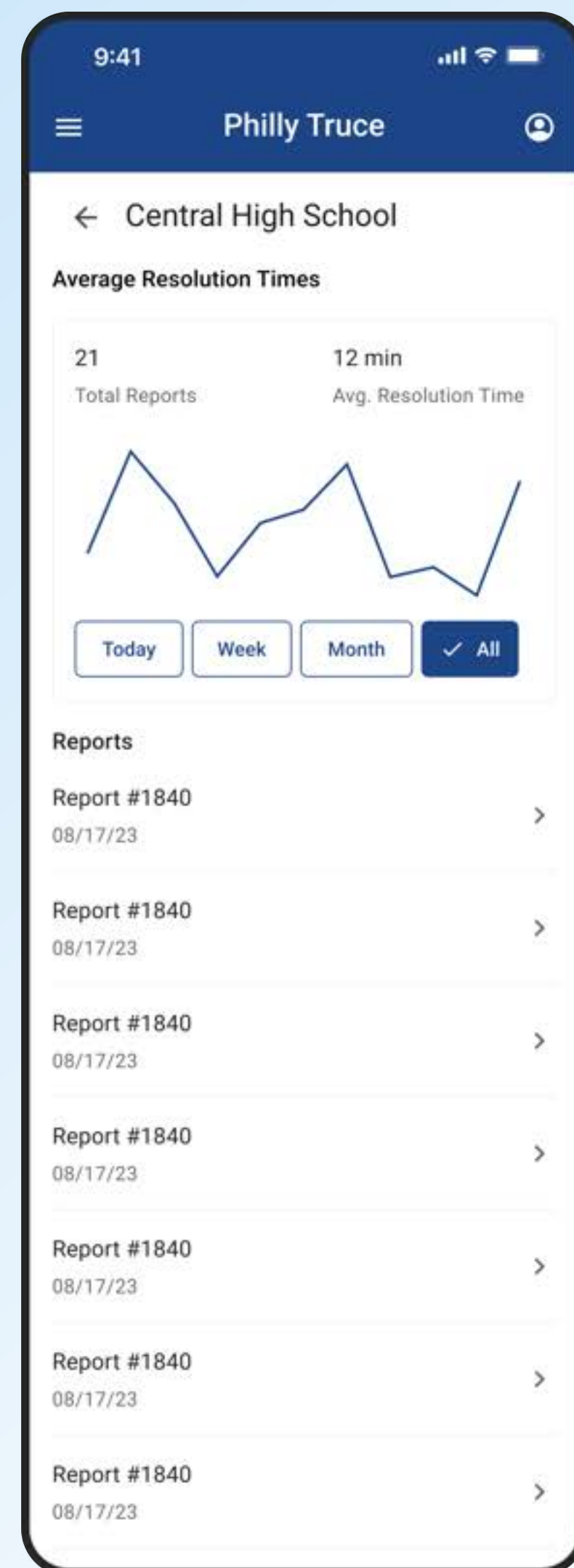
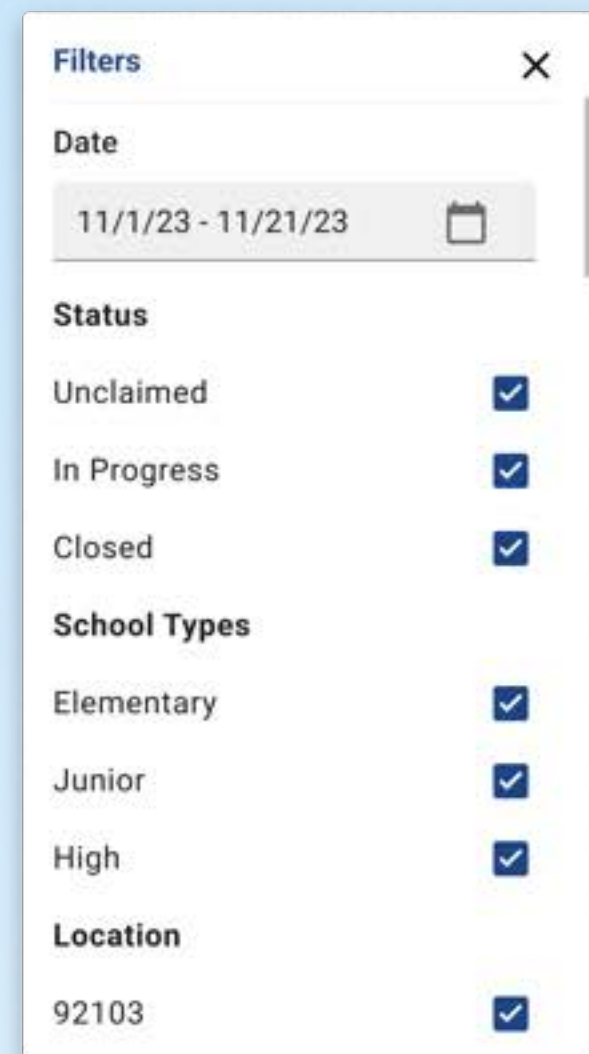
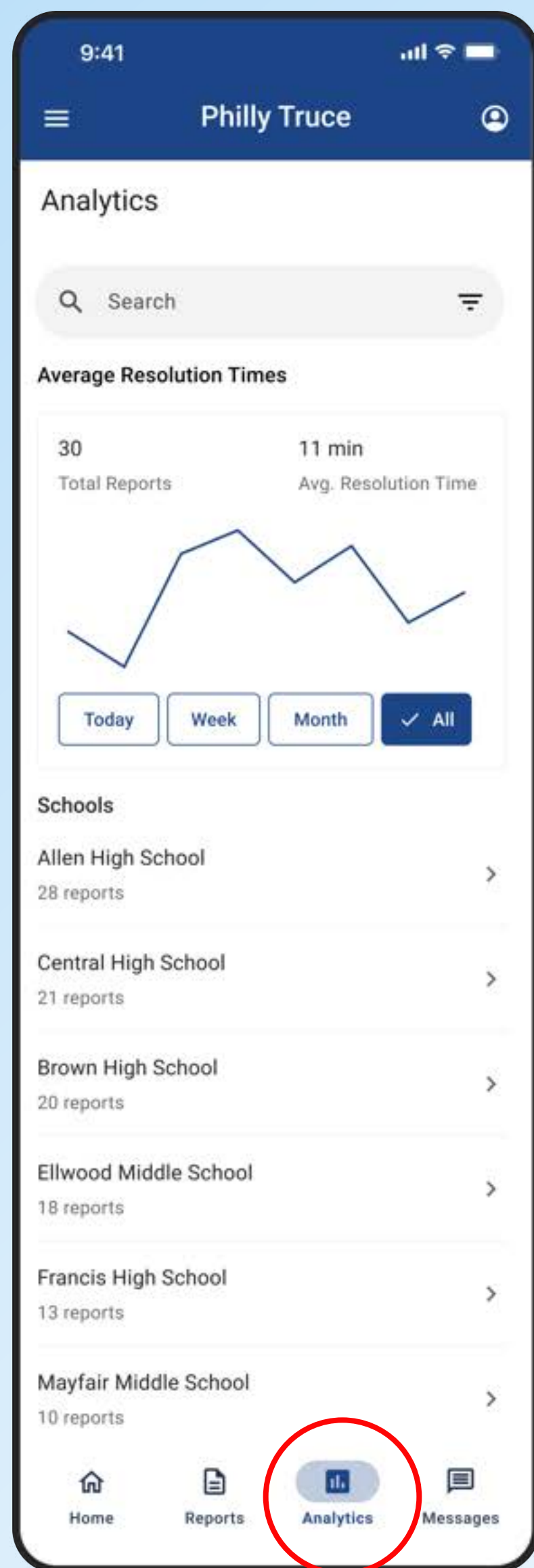
Report icon takes SPM to the report associated with student messaging,





Steps:

- SPM taps “analytics” from bottom nav bar.
- SPM can see their average resolution times broken down by:
 - Day
 - Week
 - Month
 - All
- Friendly and encouraging language directed at SPM to continue staying on track by reaching school wide goals for reporting and interventions.



Steps:

- District administrators have the same features as SPMs with some key differences:
 - Administrators can view ALL school district reports.
 - Can filter by
 - Status
 - School Type
 - Location
 - Can view individual reports and make edits to/close reports.
