SHOOTING RANGE RULES

- 1. The Shooting Range is open from 9 AM until ½ hour before Sunset.
- 2. All ERCC members must sign in the Logbook. Guests must sign in also.
- 3. You must have your Membership Card with you when on ERCC property.
- 4. The gate combination is not to be shared with anyone because of liability to ERCC. Anyone needing the gate combination can contact a member of the Board of Directors of ERCC.
- 5. ERCC Events and Rentals have priority when the "Range Closed" sign is displayed. When the Range Closed sign is displayed it means the range is closed even if the reason is not readily obvious.
- 6. No Alcohol allowed on the range.
- 7. No Smoking on the firing Line.
- 8. No children on the sand inside the backstops.
- 9. No children on the range unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 10. No Full Auto, Bump Fire, Slide fire, or Simulated Full Auto, allowed on the shooting range.
- 11. No exploding targets.
- 12. No shooting cement blocks or stones for targets.
- 13. No targets on the ground.
- 14. No targets on top of sand piles (backstops or berms) or railroad ties.
- 15. Portable wood frames that are used in the open area are to be used only for shotguns with Bird or Buck shot.
- 16. No targets are to be placed on the posts or painted orange areas.
- 17. All targets must be placed on cardboard backers.
- 18. Falling plates or other metal stationary reactive targets which are commercially made for target shooting must be placed within 12 inches in front of plywood backers.

SHOOTING RANGE SAFETY RULES

- 19. Always keep firearms pointed in a safe direction.
- 20. Keep finger off of the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 21. Eye and hearing protection must be worn.
