HOW DO I CHANGE MY BANK ACCOUNT

Send us an email or give us a call to update your bank account information we have on file.

DOES MY CARD GO INACTIVE?

If you haven't used your card in at least 6 months, your card will become inactive. Please reach out to use via phone or email to reactive your card before your next use.

WHATS MY DAILY GALLON LIMIT?

200 gallons per day

NO MORE PILOT?

No more Pilot, Flying J, or One 9! Your card will display the message "Limit has been exceeded" and will be declined!

IS MY ACCOUNT TIED TO A DEBIT/CREDIT CARD?

No, your account is tied directly to a checking or savings account.

DOES THE STATION RECEIPT SHOW THE DISCOUNTED PRICE?

No, it will always show the retail price. You can see the discounted rate in the app under Account Cards.
