


APRIL'24 PROGRAM SCHEDULE OPEN WEDNESDAY & SATURDAYS, 10AM - NOON

DARK SKIES NIGHT, APRIL 8, 7:45 PM,

Meet at Ron Morriss Park in Tubac. Our Dark Skies evening will be led by Emilio Falco, from the Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory (retired). Emilio managed telescopes at Whipple Observatory, and conducted research on galaxies, quasars, supernovae and exoplanets with groundand space telescopes. His work resulted in the publication of over 500 articles in astronomy journals. Currently, he is chair of the Southern Arizona Chapter of **DarkSky International**, and the **Tubac Dark Sky Committee** that is seeking approval of a Dark Sky designation for Tubac.
