


9520 Kids on the GO!









The 95210 Kids on the Go! Program was implemented by the NCH Safe & Health Children's Coalition in 2012 with the Collier County Public Schools as an effort to increase physical activity and decrease the incidence of obesity among kids. What began in Spring 2012 at two Title I elementary schools, has now expanded to over 30 elementary schools.

Participants in the 95210 Kids on the Go! program run a total of 26.2 miles, the equivalent of a full marathon over the course of the school year. Children are provided a weekly 9-5-2-1-0 health start-up and track their walk/run distance using the Marathon Kids program before or after school. Health champions track and celebrate children's progress and those kids who achieve the 26.2 mile goal can participate in a final celebratory mile run at the local feeder high school.

At the final mile celebration, parents, teachers, and local officials cheer children on to complete the final mile. Each child receives a t-shirt and, upon successful completion of their run, they also receive a medal as well as fresh fruit and water.

21,135 children have participated and 45 final mile runs have been hosted since the program's inception.

During the course of the program, students build endurance, increase self-confidence, and embrace the healthy lifestyle principles of the 95210 Let's Go! Campaign and staff at participating schools report the program also has a positive impact on behavior and ability to focus for the day as well as promoting Leader in Me qualities.

The Program also received the 2020 SHAPE Florida Community Partner in Health Award.



CCPS GO PROGRAM

In 2023, CCPS piloted the Go Program with Immokalee Middle School Students. The GO! Program extends the values of KOTG as a free challenge-based program designed for students that are not involved in organized sports after school to participate in weekly challenges and physical activities that will support their growth and commitment to healthy living and fitness.

Students participate in a 12-week program requiring a commitment to at least 30 minutes 2 days per week practicing various physical challenges.

The program wraps with them completing their Final Challenge Events – including 30-yard obstacle course, 50 yard fireman's carry, bleacher run, and 100 yard hurdles alongside the Final Mile Celebration at Immokalee High School.

This year it will be open to ALL CCPS MIDDLE SCHOOLS
