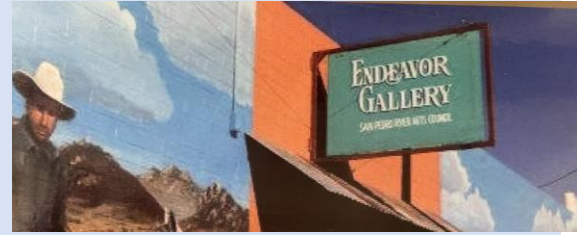

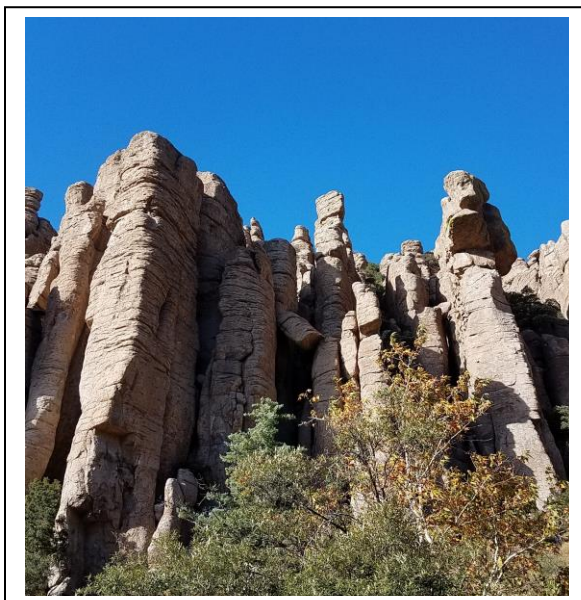

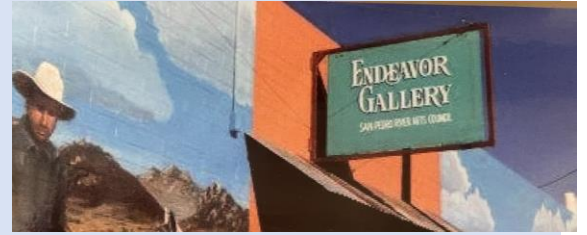

Paintings by Christine Hartzler

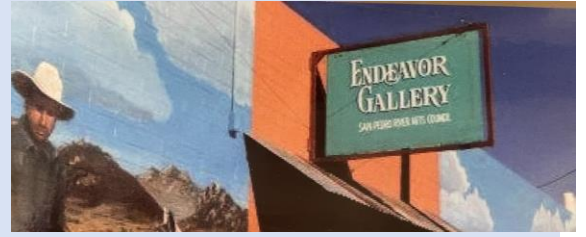
Christine has been painting since the 1970's and is famous for her distinctive palette and southwest style.
