ITTY BITTY, NOT TO EXCEED 0.65M, 2'1"— OPEN TO ANY. PEL
LEVEL 0, NOT TO EXCEED 0.8M, 2'7"— OPEN TO ANY. PEL
LEVEL 1, NOT TO EXCEED 0.9M, 2'11"— OPEN TO ANY. PEL
LEVEL 2, NOT TO EXCEED 1M, 3'3"— OPEN TO ANY.
LEVEL 3, NOT TO EXCEED 1.10M, 3'7"— OPEN TO ANY. PEL

AMATEUR EQUITATION, NOT TO EXCEED 3' FOR EACH.

OPEN TO AMATEUR RIDERS. FENCE HEIGHT MAY BE COMBINED WITH AMATEUR EQUITATION IF ENTRY WARRANT. EACH HEIGHT WILL RUN SEPARATELY IF ENTRIES WARRANT OR MAY BE COMBINED.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER, NOT TO EXCEED 2', 2'6", 3' FOR EACH SECTION-

OPEN TO JUNIOR RIDERS. FENCE HEIGHT MAY BE COMBINED WITH ADULT HUNTER IF ENTRY'S WARRANT. EACH HEIGHT WILL RUN SEPARATELY IF ENTRIES WARRANT OR MAY BE COMBINED.

ADULT HUNTER, NOT TO EXCEED 2', 2'6", 3' FOR EACH SECTION- OPEN TO AMATEUR RIDERS. FENCE HEIGHT MAY BE COMBINED WITH CHILDREN'S HUNTER IF ENTRY WARRANT. EACH HEIGHT WILL RUN SEPARATELY IF ENTRIES WARRANT OR MAY BE COMBINED.

M&S/PEL CHILD/ADULT MEDAL, NOT TO EXCEED 3'-

OPEN TO JUNIORS AND AMATEURS.

M&S ADULT HUNTER CLASSIC, NOT TO EXCEED 3' RUNS W/THIRD HUNTER CLASS.

RIDERS MUST BE AMATEURS. TWO-ROUND CLASSIC. HORSE OR PONY MUST HAVE ENTERED, SHOWN AND COMPLETED THE COURSE IN TWO HUNTER OR EQUITATION CLASSES OVER FENCES AT THE SAME SHOW.

M&S BIT O'STRAW, NOT TO EXCEED 2'6"—TWO-ROUND CLASSIC WITH THE OPTION TO DO BOTH ROUNDS BACK-TO-BACK. FENCES 2'6". RIDERS MUST BE JUNIORS OR AMATEURS. HORSE OR PONY MUST HAVE ENTERED, SHOWN AND COMPLETED THE COURSE IN TWO HUNTER OR EQUITATION CLASSES OVER FENCES AT THE SAME SHOW.

M&S / PEL CHILD/ADULT MEDAL, NOT TO EXCEED 2'6"-

OPEN TO JUNIORS AND AMATEURS.

M&S / PEL CHILDREN'S PONY MEDAL, NOT TO EXCEED 2', 2'6"-OPEN TO JUNIORS AND AMATEURS.

M&S/ PEL CHILDREN'S HUNTER CLASSIC, NOT TO EXCEED 2', 2'6" RUNS WITH THIRD HUNTER CLASS RIDERS MUST BE AMATEURS. TWO-ROUND CLASSIC. HORSE OR PONY MUST HAVE ENTERED, SHOWN AND COMPLETED THE COURSE IN TWO HUNTER OR EQUITATION CLASSES OVER FENCES AT THE SAME SHOW.

ALL CLASSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR OUTREACH EXCEPT LEANDLINE AND PLEASURE

CLASSES 1, 2 3 4 PEL

MINI STIRRUP EQUITATION, NOT TO EXCEED GROUND POLES - OPEN TO JUNIOR RIDERS 10 YRS. OF AGE & UNDER. RIDERS MAY NOT HAVE COMPETED MORE THAN 1 TIME IN A CLASS REQUIRING THEM TO CANTER. **CLASSES 5, 6, 7, 8**

WALK TROT EQUITATION, NOT TO EXCEED GROUND POLES - OPEN TO JUNIOR & AMATEUR RIDERS 11 YEARS OF AGE & OVER. RIDERS MAY NOT HAVE COMPETED MORE THAN 1 TIME IN A CLASS REQUIRING THEM TO CANTER. **CLASSES 9, 10, 11 12 PEL**
BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION, 11 YRS AND UNDER NOT TO EXCEED 18"— OPEN TO JUNIOR RIDERS 11 YEARS OF AGE & UNDER WHO HAVE NOT SHOWN BEYOND CROSS RAILS. TROTting NOT PENALIZED. CANTERING IN ONE AT A TIME. FENCES: CROSS RAILS WITHOUT FILLERS, UNDER 18".

CLASSES 13, 14 15, 16 PEL

BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION, 12 AND OVER NOT TO EXCEED 18"- OPEN TO JUNIOR & AMATEUR RIDERS 12 YEARS OF AGE & OVER WHO HAVE NOT SHOWN BEYOND CROSS RAILS. TROTting NOT PENALIZED. CANTERING IN ONE AT A TIME. FENCES: CROSS RAILS WITHOUT FILLERS, UNDER 18".

CLASSES 17 18 19 LEAD LINE EQUITATION, PEL NOT TO EXCEED GROUND POLES - OPEN JUNIOR

RIDERS 9 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER. RIDERS MAY NOT HAVE COMPETED OFF THE LEAD OR IN ANY OTHER CLASS/DIVISION AT ANY SHOW. LEADER AND SIDE WALKERS MUST BE OVER THE AGE OF 14 AND APPROPRIATELY DRESSED.

CLASS 20 SHINEY HINEY 50/50 PAYBACK SCHOLARSHIP CLASS— JUDGED IN HAND WITH HALTER AND LEAD. HORSES WILL BE JUDGED BASED ON THE BEST GROOMED. \$25.00 PER ENTRY WILL BE ADDED TO THE PRIZE PURSE. 50% OF THE PRIZE PURSE GOES TO THE WINNER OF THE CLASS AND THE OTHER 50% WILL BE COLLECTED THROUGHOUT THE SHOW YEAR AND ADD TO THE HVHS SCHOLARSHIP FUND.

CLASSES 21 22 23 24

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION PEL NOT TO EXCEED 18"- OPEN TO JUNIOR RIDERS 12 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER AS OF DEC. 1ST OF THE CURRENT SHOW YEAR. TROTting NOT PENALIZED.

CLASSES 25 26 27 28

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION, 18"— OPEN TO JUNIOR AND AMATEUR RIDERS 13 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER. TROTting NOT PENALIZED.

SHORT LONG STIRRUP HUNTER DERBY DERBY HAS A TWO-ROUND FORMAT. THE FIRST ROUND IS A CLASSIC ROUND, RUN WITH THE THIRD HUNTER OVER FENCE CLASS WHERE A HORSE IS JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, PACE, JUMPING STYLE, QUALITY AND MOVEMENT. THE SECOND ROUND IS A HANDY HUNTER ROUND, WHICH ENCOURAGES BRILLIANCE OF PACE (A MORE FORWARD, GALLOPING STRIDE) AND HANDINESS, WHICH MEANS RIDERS OPT FOR TIGHTER TURNS AND DIFFERENT TRACKS TO FENCES THAN THOSE TRADITIONALLY TAKEN IN A HUNTER ROUND. JUDGES USE A NUMERICAL SCORING SYSTEM TO RATE THE HORSES AFTER EACH ROUND OF COMPETITION. THREE OPTIONAL FENCES WILL BE OFFERED FOR MORE POINTS

CROSS RAIL HUNTER, PEL 29, 30, 31, 32 , OPEN TO ALL RIDERS AND ALL HORSES NOT TO EXCEED 18" CROSSRAILS, TROTting NOT PENALIZED

CROSSRAIL JUMPERS , PEL 18" 33, 34, 35 OPEN TO ALL RIDGES AND ALL HORSES NOT TO EXCEED 18" CROSSRAILS, TROTting NOT PENALIZED.

INTRO JUMPERS , PEL 18" 36 37 38 OPEN TO ALL RIDGES AND ALL HORSES NOT TO EXCEED 18" STRAIGHT RAIL, TROTting NOT PENALIZED.F

Class: 172 - FWPFA Medal Eq 2' 2'6" 3'

PRE SCHOOLING HUNTER 18" OPEN TO ALL RIDERS AND HORSES NOT TO EXCEED 18" STRAIGHT RAIL
Open to horses & ponies ridden by riders of ANY age. Fences LESS THAN 2' in height. Section A: Rider may not have shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Riders in section A may not cross enter in any division or class at any competition where fences are 2' or higher. The rider will be no longer eligible for Beginner's. Section B: Horse or pony not to have shown in a division, at any competition, where fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Horses may not cross enter into any division or class where fences are 2' or higher at the same competition.

MODIFIED EQUITATION 18", 36-39 OPEN TO AMATUER RIDERS, NOT TO EXCEED 18" STRAIGHT RAIL OPEN TO EXHIBITORS OF ANY AGE WHO HAVE NOT SHOWN IN A DIVISION, AT ANY SHOW, WHERE THE FENCE HEIGHT SPECIFICATIONS ARE 2' OR HIGHER. TO BE SHOWN OVER A COURSE LESS THAN 2'. RIDERS MAY NOT CROSS ENTER INTO ANY OTHER DIVISION OR CLASS WHERE FENCES ARE 2' OR HIGHER. TROTting ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

DERBY HAS A TWO-ROUND FORMAT. THE FIRST ROUND IS A CLASSIC ROUND, RUN WITH THE THIRD HUNTER OVER FENCE CLASS WHERE A HORSE IS JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, PACE, JUMPING STYLE, QUALITY AND MOVEMENT.
