Studio Policies & Procedures

Tuition

Tuition is charged monthly and is due on the 1st of each month. Tuition for August and June is prorated at 50%. At no other time does Planet Dance pro-rate tuition. Studio closures for calendar holidays and breaks are figured into tuition rates. A late fee of \$30 is added to all tuition payments collected after the 5th of each month. Dancers with accounts not paid in full by the 10th of each month will be unable to return to class until the balance is paid in full. There is also a \$50 returned check fee for all returned checks. There are no refunds for missed classes or dropping without notice. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable.

If you would like to pay the entire year's tuition, we are able to offer a 10% discount. Tuition must be paid in full for the entire year by August 31, 2023, in order to receive the discount. Please see the front desk for more details.

Registration Fee

A \$50 registration fee per dancer is due in August of each year or at the start of a dancer's season. If a family has more than one dancer (immediate family only), registration fees for the year will be capped at \$100 per family. Registration fees are nonrefundable or transferable.

Attendance

Attendance in all classes is crucial in providing consistency and continuous improvement throughout the season. Arriving 5 minutes before class is strongly encouraged, as well as, prompt pick-up after classes. Planet Dance cares for the safety of its students but is not responsible for students outside of class times or for students leaving the studio.

Absences

Attendance is very important! If a student is going to be absent from a class, the parent should call the studio and leave a message so that we can notify the teacher. There are no refunds for missed classes. Regular attendance is essential to ensure the personal growth of your dancer and the progression of the class.

Withdrawals

Planet Dance withdrawals anytime during the year and must occur by the 15th of each month. If a dancer chooses to withdraw after the 15th of the month, they will still be responsible for the following month's tuition. If a student withdrawals after November 1, 2023, they are still responsible for all costume <u>and</u> recital fees associated with their account.

IMPORTANT NOTE: We only accept withdrawal notices via our online portal. Email, phone, and verbal withdrawals will not be honored. We do not issue pro-rated refunds for any unused tuition or classes.



Studio Atmosphere

Planet Dance strives to provide a positive environment for all faculty, students, and parents. Negative, disrespectful, and rude behavior is NOT tolerated. Please help us create an encouraging environment for our students to grow and prosper. Furthermore, we aim to provide a focused and structured class regime and therefore limit observation within the studios.

Lost & Found

Students and parents are responsible for picking up after themselves (food, beverages, trash, etc.) and all personal belongings. Food and beverages are permitted in the common areas only! Only water is allowed within the studios. The lost and found is in the lobby. Any unclaimed items are donated at the end of each month.

Studio Closures & Holidays

Planet Dance abides by the Berkeley County School District (BCSD) for severe weather closures. If BCSD announces school closure due to weather, Planet Dance will also be closed for all classes that day. We will inform all families via email and a post to social media by 2pm for all afternoon and evening classes.

We also follow the BCSD Instructional Calendar for holidays and breaks (not including MLK Day and President's Day). All closures are notated in the studio calendar below.

Annual Dress Rehearsal and Recital

Planet Dance will have one year-end recital held on June 8, 2024. There will be a mandatory dress rehearsal the day before the recital to give dancers the opportunity to perform all their routines on stage before performing them live in front of an audience. Dress Rehearsal is mandatory for all dancers performing in the recital.

All students are strongly encouraged to participate in the recital. If your dancer does not wish to participate in the recital, please contact the director by November 1, 2023 in order to avoid costume and recital fees. If a student withdrawals after this date they are still responsible for all costume and recital fees associated with their account regardless of participation.

Miscellaneous

- Dancers are not allowed in the studio until an instructor invites them.
- Students must be supervised when not in the dance room.
- No running, yelling, or horseplay in the lobby or common areas.
- NO cell phones, gum, or food are allowed in class.
- Planet Dance is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Planet Dance reserves the right to refuse service to a parent or dancer if inappropriate behavior occurs. If a parent or dancer is asked to leave the studio, all fees and outstanding payments must be paid, and no refunds will be provided.



Class Descriptions

Classes are separated by ages and skill level. Level placement is at the sole discretion of the director.

<u>Primary I:</u> For dancers ages 3-4 years old, this class introduces basic ballet and tap techniques along with creative movement and dance vocabulary in a structured class environment. Students develop rhythm, coordination, and movement while building their confidence and self-esteem.

<u>Primary II:</u> For dancers ages 5-6 years old, this class reviews and builds on the basic ballet and tap technique learned in Primary I as well as introducing new vocabulary and movements in a structured class environment. This class is designed to help dancers transition into our Petite classes.

<u>Bit Bop:</u> For dancers ages 4-6 years old, this class is an introduction to Jazz with Hip-Hop infusion and incorporates coordination, movement, visual stimulation, and games to keep the dancers learning and having fun.

<u>Ballet:</u> The ballet program teaches dancers strong techniques through traditional ballet. Students learn proper placement, turnout, technique, and vocabulary in a disciplined environment while developing strong work ethics and a solid technique foundation in a positive atmosphere. We highly recommend all dancers take at least one ballet class per week. <u>Pointe classes are incorporated into the Ballet 4 class and are by teacher approval only!</u>

<u>Jazz:</u> Jazz focuses on building strong technique, strength, and flexibility. Classes incorporate stretching, across-the-floor combinations, and choreography. Students learn different turns, jumps, leaps, and extensions while incorporating them into many different styles of jazz.

<u>Tap:</u> The tap program concentrates on both rhythmic and classical tap methods. Students learn vocabulary, rhythmic timing, improvisation, and choreography across the floor and in choreography.

<u>Contemporary:</u> Contemporary classes fuse together ballet, jazz, lyrical, and modern dance styles. This style of dance challenges dancers to grow as artists through movement. Dancers will work across the floor and with choreography throughout the season.

<u>Hip-Hop:</u> This fun and upbeat class integrates many different styles of hip-hop including pop and lock, street, and break dancing. Students learn isolation of movement and body control techniques and choreography as well as trending dance moves in pop culture.

<u>Acro:</u> This class incorporates gymnastic technique, flexibility training, stunting, and partner work. Dancers will work on flexibility and strength training, as well as, building interpersonal and group working skills.

<u>Tumble Tots:</u> This class is designed for dancers ages 4 to 6. This class introduces basic acrobatic skills, creative movement, and dance vocabulary and technique in a structured class environment. Students develop rhythm, coordination, and movement while building their confidence and self-esteem.



Class Descriptions (cont.)

<u>Technique</u>: Our technique classes are designed to help dancers take their jazz, contemporary, and ballet technique to the next level while building their strength and stamina. In this class, dancers will work on a variety of jumps, turns, and leaps while increasing their flexibility and cardio ability. This class is the perfect pairing with a weekly ballet, jazz, or tap class. Technique classes are not included in the recital.

<u>Music & Movement 1:</u> Our Music and Movement 1 class is designed for dancers ages 3 and 4. In this class, dancers will experience songs and rhymes to develop phonetic awareness, focused listening with music to improve skills in following directions, instrument play to strengthen fine motor skills, learn to emphasize storytelling, imaginative play, and so much more. Currently, Music and Movement classes are 7 weeks long and are not included in the recital.

<u>Music & Movement 2:</u> Our Music and Movement 2 builds on the skills learned in the Music and Movement 1 class. This class is designed for dancers ages 5 and 6. In this class, dancers will develop skills to recognize note values and counting, gain a deeper understanding of music concepts, and learn participation in movement and play to build gross motor skills and body spatial awareness. Currently, Music and Movement classes are 7 weeks long and are not included in the recital.





Tuition & Fees

Annual Registration Fee

- \$50 is due at the time of registration and is paid annually in August
- If you register before the start of classes on August 21, you will receive a free Planet Dance T-shirt
- Family Registration (more than 1 dancer) is \$100 maximum
- All registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable

Tuition

- Tuition is paid monthly and due on the 1st of each month
 - Classes start August 21, 2023, and go through June 6, 2024
 - Tuition is calculated per dancer, not per family
 - A 10% discount is offered for immediate family only
- Auto-pay credit cards are processed between the 1st and 5th of each month
 - August is the only month that auto-pay will be processed on August 21, the first day of classes.
- Tuition is broken down into 11 payments over the course of the season
 - ONLY August and June tuition is prorated at 50%; at no other time does Planet Dance prorate tuition
- A late fee of \$30 will automatically be applied to tuition not paid by the 5th of each month
- There is a \$50 fee for all returned checks.
- If tuition is not paid by the 10th of each month, the dancer will be unable to return to class until tuition is paid.
- Private lessons are also available upon request. Please see the director for more information and/or to schedule a
 private lesson.

Costume & Recital Fees

- All costume <u>and</u> recital fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable.
- Costume Fee: \$100 per dancer per class
 - Due by November 15
- Recital fee: \$75 per student (not per family)
 - Due by February 15

Late Fees

A late fee of \$30 will automatically be applied to fees not paid on time. This includes but is not limited to, tuition, costume deposits and balances, recital fees, and competition entry fees (competitive team only).

Dress Code

Primary Classes:

Girls: A leotard with pink or tan tights. A tutu or

dance skirt may be worn.

Boys: Solid color t-shirt with gym or dance

shorts.



Bit Bop, Hip-Hop, & Music and Movement: Any T-Shirt or tank top with leggings, joggers, or shorts, and tights. Jeans or overly baggy pieces of clothing are not acceptable.



Jazz, Tap, Contemporary, & Technique: Fitted dancewear or athletic clothing including a leotard, unitard, crop top, shorts, fitted tops.






Ballet:

Boys: A solid color t-shirt with dance tights or leggings.






Acro, Tumble Tots:

Any leotard, athletic short, or tight-fitting tops (ex. crop top) that will not fall over the face when a dancer is tumbling.
