The Save Acworth History Foundation awards scholarships to high school graduating seniors who are interested in majoring or minoring in history. SAHF reserves the exclusive right to determine the number of scholarships awarded.

About Save Acworth History Foundation (SAHF)

Save Acworth History Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit dedicated to preserving and promoting the history of Acworth, GA. Our goal is to collect video histories, photos and artifacts that reflect our history as a railroad town and center of an agricultural community. Many of these items are on display in the downtown Depot Park History Center.

RECIPIENT'S OBLIGATION

Acceptance of the award constitutes permission for SAHF to use the recipient's name and recognition as a recipient of the scholarship in the organization's publications and announcements. Furthermore, recipient agrees to provide official documentation indicating full time enrollment at the college or university of her choice before payment will be made. Failure to supply documentation as a registered degree seeking student will result in revocation of the full amount of the award.

Award Notification and Payment

Scholarships will be awarded at the school's awards night. Payment will be made in August directly to the college or university on behalf of the recipient.

SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES

Eligibility Criteria

1. Graduating high school senior from one of the following schools: North Cobb High Allatoona High Harrison High Kennesaw Mountain High North Cobb Christian Cornerstone Brookwood Christian Or a home-schooled student residing in one of these school districts 2. Minimum GPA 3.25 3. Demonstration of active participation in extracurricular activities

Application Criteria

Applicant should complete include and submit all the following for consideration. Any incomplete applications will not receive consideration: 1. Resume listing all school community and or extracurricular activities including leadership positions. 2. Copy of high school transcript 3. Letter of support from a teacher who is qualified to address the candidate's qualities, community impact, and suitability for this award 4. Personally written essay of 500 words or less outlining the applicant's future goals, aspirations, and college plans. The essay should share what aspect of history is of interest to him/her. Please tell us: do you feel that it is important to be familiar with history and why? If you feel that an interest in history has contributed to fulfillment of future goals and aspirations, please explain.

STUDENT RESUME

Please list in reverse chronological order, beginning with the most recent year, any extracurricular activities including Fine Arts and athletics, leadership roles, community service, significant accomplishments, awards, and honors received during your high school career.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

One signed letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or school administrator must be included.

Applications must be received no later than March 31. Incomplete applications or applications received after this date will not be considered. Please submit application, resume, letter of recommendation, and high school transcript to saveacworthhistory@gmail.com.
