

Member Payment Plan Options

Membership Dues Options

CMSA now offers several options for paying your membership dues.

Traditional Annual Payments

Pay your annual dues in full and receive a renewal notice/invoice prompting payment for the next member year. This payment option is available to all Member Types.

Two Year Membership

CMSA now offers a 2-Year membership at a discounted rate of \$310 for A & B members, and \$216 for military members. A savings of \$15 per year over the regular annual rate. Two years local chapter dues are required at time of join/renew to take advantage of the savings. The 2-year membership is available only for Member Types Individual A/B, and Military. The 2-year membership is not available in conjunction with monthly dues payment plan.

Automated Monthly Dues Payment Plan

1. CMSA now offers the budget-friendly, monthly payment plan. These payments will be charged to your credit card each month until you choose to cancel your membership, or change payment types. See cancellation policy for more information. The first payment includes 1/12 of National dues, full payment of local chapter^{*}, and .84 cents/month processing fee. Remaining 11 months will reflect 1/12 of National dues (and .84 cent monthly processing fee). Available to Member types A and B only.


*Chapter Dues will be charged in full in the first installment payment and automatically renewed annually when opting for the monthly payment plan. The installment plan is not currently available for chapter dues.

Example Monthly Auto Installment Payment: National dues \$170. Chapter dues \$20.

First monthly payment: National= \$14.16, Chapter= \$20, and Processing Fee= .84 for a total of \$35. Remaining monthly payments: National= \$14.16 + Processing Fee= .84 for a total of \$15.

Impact Rehab and Wellness

Providing Physical and Occupational Therapy in Okmulgee OK

What is blood flow restriction therapy and how can it help patients recover faster?

Therapy services:

Our private practice clinic sees a variety of patients from rural Oklahoma with a range of injuries, chronic and acute. We offer PT and OT services such as functional dry needling, surface EMG biofeedback, and instrument assisted soft tissue mobilization. We offer specialty services by our certified lymphedema and certified hand therapist (CHT). We also offer functional movement screening.

Blood Flow Restriction (BFR):


Over the years we have found significant improvement in our patients as they report decreased pain and demonstrate improved ROM and strength with the use of personalized Blood Flow Restriction (BFR) training during their therapy sessions. We have seen those patients also recover faster and achieve their goals faster.

We are one of around 10 clinics in Oklahoma that specialize in the use of personal Blood Flow Restriction (BFR) training specifically with the Delfi PTS unit by Owens Recovery Science. Research has demonstrated how exercise with the use of BFR is beneficial with injuries and post-operative patients as patients can perform gentle low load exercise but get the benefit of a higher intensity more physically demanding work out. The reason for this effect is that when you are traditionally exercising your muscles are in an aerobic state, but when you exercise with the BFR cuff on your arm or leg it creates an anaerobic state in the muscle which causes chemical changes in the muscle and surrounding tissues such as higher lactate levels, increased growth hormone, increased insulin like growth factor, increased myogenic stem cells, and a decrease in myostatin. Even using the BFR without exercise can help avoid atrophy in the muscle by inducing protein synthesis. Research has shown that on average, people lose at least 30% of their muscle strength within the first few days following surgery. It has been found that post operative patients do not lose as much muscle strength when their exercises include the use of BFR. This results in a quicker recovery time and less therapy visits to achieve rehab goals. Lastly and also noteworthy, many patients report a reduction of pain after performing exercises with the BFR. Unique to the Delfi unit, is a large tapered cuff patients wear during their exercise that also contains a real time doppler that continually monitors the optimal and safest pressure when performing exercises and this prevents the chance of skin or nerve injury that may occur with other types of BFR. During medical school, he was a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Society.

He is a member of the American Orthopedic Society for Sports Medicine, Arthroscopy Association of North America and the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons.


