IT'S ALL ABOUT CHELSEA F.C.!

February saw the finale of the "Moving Beyond Respect and Inclusion Training" provided to over 800 coaches and staff members at Chelsea F.C. Craig and Daniel have been delivering this training since May 2023 and have received 5\* reviews from the staff at the club.



The "Moving Beyond Respect and Inclusion Training" is a comprehensive training session designed for the coaches and staff across Premier League football clubs.

This training program provides a comprehensive understanding of harassment and misogyny in professional environments. Participants explore various forms of destructive behavior, including bullying and gaslighting, while learning to recognise power dynamics and promote allyship. Discussions also cover relevant legislation and emphasize developing response skills to address incidents effectively. The training aims to foster a respectful and inclusive club culture that discourages oppressive behavior.

The second portion of the training adopts a therapeutic approach, led by a qualified therapist. This open forum provides a safe space for individuals to discuss, reflect on, and explore their experiences with harassment in a supportive environment.

By taking a mental health-centered approach, we highlight the emotional repercussions of harassment, prioritising the wellbeing of those affected. Through this trauma-informed perspective, we strive to foster a compassionate and understanding club environment that encourages open communication and personal growth.
