Replacement lever style knob for those often broken antenna loading, filter selection, and RF gain knobs on the Heath SB-Line and the HW-100 and HW-101.

Two versions are available, one cast in metal and the other cast in resin. The knobs are slightly different from some of the knobs supplied originally in that they all have a setscrew and do NOT have the non-setscrew version with the two tabs that just "slip" onto the shaft. The setscrew version can be used in place of the tab version. The metal version is stronger than those made from resin. However, the resin versions are as strong as the original knobs if not stronger.

Also, because of problems when casting the metal knobs, some knobs do NOT have the raised ridge around the perimeter of the knob. However, this raised area is not visible when the outer knob is in position.

The setscrew is larger in diameter than those on the original knobs.

The green paint used on the knobs can vary slightly from the color of some of the original knobs. If desired, the replacement knob can be supplied painted black instead of green.

Please note that these knobs are "hand cast" and, therefore, there can be slight differences, imperfections, etc., among the knobs.

Price per metal knob is \$19.95 except those sold to persons in the State of Texas. Texas residents must add 8.25-percent sales tax which makes the price \$21.60 each. Shipping charges are extra.

Price per resin knob is \$9.99 each except those sold to persons in the State of Texas. Texas residents must add 8.25-percent sales tax which makes the price \$10.81. Shipping charges are extra.
