



SRCF ANNUAL REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY
2018-2019

Your **Spring Run Charitable Foundation** has just completed its twelfth year of fundraising for Local Charities in Lee and Collier Counties and what a year it has been! With the revenues we raised from the Home Tour, Cash Raffle, Golf Outing, Silent and Live Auctions, and the generous cash donations made by Spring Run residents, we distributed \$194,000 on March 24, 2019.

INTERFAITH CHARITIES OF SOUTH LEE - \$20,000

Monies provide a food pantry, financial assistance, budget classes, transportation, free income tax services, summer lunch for kids, and Meals on Wheels to those in need.

LACES OF LOVE - \$21,500

Since 2008 over 100,000 pairs of shoes have been distributed to disadvantaged children in Lee and Collier Counties.

FGCU FOOD PANTRY - \$5,000

This donation helps supplement their food drive with fresh fruits and vegetables along with adding variety to shelf-staple options for more than 500 students who experience food insecurity.

OPERATION OPEN ARMS - \$30,500

Their mission is to support Active Duty Servicemen/women and Veterans with special needs; to provide R&R, and a range of services to contribute to their health and well-being.

NEW HORIZONS - \$21,500

New Horizons is committed to empower at-risk youth to reach their full potential through tutoring, mentoring, and faith.

LITERACY COUNCIL GULF COAST - \$20,000

The Literacy Council is committed to assisting adults and children to acquire language and reading skills and the education necessary to improve their quality of life and to enhance the entire community.
