

Report of Committees

2019 National Specialty:

- Tracking: After viewing Tracking at the National it is clear there is lots of time and effort involved for the benefit of very few people. Sally will put out to the ECSCA Board that we will not be offering Tracking, unless someone is willing to step up as chair and obtain the needed volunteers. We asked the tracking folks at the National if any were planning to come to California in 2019. None responded that they would be coming or were even thinking about it.

- Judge's Hospitality Chair: We need someone who's not showing to be in charge of the judge's activities prior to and during the Specialty.

- Show Superintendent: Will be Foy Trent, who just did the Minnesota National. They need us to provide a local contact as their onsite liaison to make sure the judge's book, etc. is properly submitted to AKC. Sue checked with Doris Bandoian to see if she was available. She needs to check her calendar. If so, she would charge \$100 per day and possibly need lodging. If she does require lodging, this could push the cost too high, so we may have to find other candidates.

- Extended Generation Stud Dog / Brood Bitch: We have sent a letter to the Parent Club informing them we're planning on doing this Special Event in which 3 generations (the entered stud dog or brood bitch, their get, and the get's get) are in the ring for judging. We could use one of the English contingent as our surprise judge (not Andrew Jones, since he just judged the National last year)

- Titer Clinic: We're going to try to add this to our health clinic, in order to help people avoid unnecessary vaccinations. Sally will talk to Bruce.

- Lanyards: Maureen Mybeck will be in charge. Lanyard will serve as name tag with kennel names, will contain the daily schedules, and will also be the entry pass for activities.

- Boutique: Deb McClelland will be in charge.

- Welcome Party: Will be a Slider Bar (mini hamburgers).

- Fun Event: Pet Parade - for ECS who are not entered in Conformation or Performance events. They will receive the Couch Potato award.

- Top Dog: Will not be having - Parent Club Board voted to discontinue this event.

- Welcome Bags: Sally needs more towels. Lynda suggested only 200 bags instead of 250 based on anticipated entry. Lainey will be making special leashes for each type of event, so each welcome bag will be specific for each type of event - agility, obedience, nose work, etc. Sue is going to contact First Mate (dog food company) to see if they will provide 200 samples for the welcome bags. They would like to be a vendor at the national and are willing to donate to the event.

- Video: Jack has a contact who does video to see if we can get a better price for the National DVD than this year's. Sue is also going to ask Bettina if she knows anyone.

- National Merchandise: Maureen Mybeck will place an ad in each Review prior to our National and will include photos of Eileen's 5 art pieces. We will auction off the originals prior to any information being disseminated about the signed prints. Sally will contact Shannon Loritz, who did the online auction for 2018, for ideas.

- Calendars: We need to have a separate calendar meeting. We'll use our own photos that Jack or any other club member has. We'll us higher quality paper than they used for 2018. We don't want to print too many, so we don't end up with a bunch of extras.

• 2018 Summer Specialty:

-Sue needs the insurance rider to provide to Summerfest and Doris. Jack will contact the insurance agent.

- Need lunches for Judges and Stewards. Sally will ask Lainey for list of those working Obedience / Rally ring.

- Sally is waiting for Ribbons. She will need the class numbers as soon as entries close, so we don't get any ribbons we don't need. She has coloring books and participation ribbons for PeeWee.
