### Oak Wilt:

Retraction to Arbor Day article published in the April newsletter

Trees are an important public resource that enhances the quality of life, adds value to properties, and reduces energy costs and pollutants. Our City Arborist has some tips you can follow to help prevent Oak Wilt in your neighborhood:

- Minimize pruning oak trees between February 1 and July 1. This is when the Oak Wilt fungus is most active.
- The best time to prune trees is either in the middle of the summer, when temperatures are the hottest, or in late fall/early winter months when temperatures can be the coldest.
- Paint all cuts and wounds on oak trees within 30 minutes.
- Remove Red Oaks identified with Oak Wilt.
- Know where your firewood comes from. Don't transport unseasoned firewood from diseased Red Oaks.
- Make sure contractors doing tree pruning have a valid, city issued tree maintenance license and proper training.

### **Pool Opened April 1 with Keycard Access**

Effective April 1, the WOS Pool opened for <u>unguarded</u> swimming (swim at your own risk; no lifeguards on duty). Full members, if you haven't yet gotten your keycard to access the community pool, please download the liability waiver from our website at www.woodsofshavano.com and have all adult members of your household sign it. Return the completed form to the clubhouse mailbox and your keycard will be mailed to you. Keycards will be required to access the pool even when lifeguards are on duty. Do not miss out!

#### **Pool Hours:**

The pool is now accessible to full members from April 1st to October 31st between the hours of 7 AM and 8 PM for unguarded, swim at your own risk. In addition, our lifeguards will be on duty during summer vacation from June 3rd to August 27th from 1 PM to 8 PM T/W/Th/Sun and from 1 PM to 9 PM Fri/Sat.

Please note the pool is not available during swim practice times, May 1st – June 2nd from 4:30 PM -7:30 PM and June 5th – 23rd from 8:30 AM – 11:30 AM. In addition, the pool will be closed during the swim home meets on 5/27/23 and 6/10/23 from 7 AM to 12 PM. Come out and cheer for our sharks!

#### **Pool Guest Pass Policy Updated**

For the 2023 season, each household will now be allowed 2 free guests per day. Additional guests are subject to a \$5 entrance fee. During SAYOR hours, please leave your guest fee in the honor box or make an electronic payment through the link at the woodsofshavano.com website.

# **Be a Good Neighbor –**Follow Code Compliance Laws About Dogs

#### **Leash Laws**

Recently, there have been concerns about loose dogs in the neighborhood involving serious injuries. Dogs allowed to run loose and unsupervised can prevent homeowners from safely walking, jogging, or riding bicycles.

The City of San Antonio Animal Code states the following:

All dogs must be confined to their owner's property at all times except when on a leash. Animal Care officers have the legal authority to enter unenclosed front yards of private property to impound unrestrained animals.

Be a responsible and friendly neighbor. Keep your dogs safe from harm. Prevent injury to others. Prevent your pet from being impounded by Animal Care. If you witness a dog out of its yard or not being walked on a leash, first, respectfully speak to your neighbor who isn't following the law. If that doesn't work, report the problem to Code Compliance at 311. Your report can be anonymous.

If you are one of the offending owners, you don't want your dog picked up by Animal Care. Show respect for your neighbors and for the law -- keep your dog safely in the yard. When walking your pet, it must be on a leash.

# Poop Happens, but PLEASE, Not in My Yard!



Another problem related to dogs in the neighborhood has been brought to the WOSCA Board's attention; dogs doing their "business" on neighbors' lawns and irresponsible owners not cleaning up the poop. Again, there is a Code Compliance ordinance against this:

A pet owner or keeper shall not walk his/her dogs without a leash restraint, and shall not guide or take animals onto the yards or driveways of property not owned, leased, or occupied by the animal owner for the purpose of allowing the animal to defecate, but shall keep his/her animal in the public right-of-way, and shall carry a container or scooper for the sanitary removal of his/her fecal matter from the public right-of-way.

While Board members are happy to hear your concerns, the fastest and most efficient way of handling issues such as this (if you have asked the owner to comply with the ordinance) is by calling Code Compliance at 311. They usually come within a few days to address the problem. They will need information about the animal's description, owner, and address. Animals bring pleasure to people's lives. Responsible ownership includes caring for them and respecting the rights of neighbors.

### **City Code Enforcement**

The WOSCA is a volunteer association and does not have the ability to enforce city codes. *You* can report code compliance issues in the neighborhood. Simply **call 311** to report your code compliance concern.

#### Common issues that warrant reporting:

- Junked or abandoned vehicles
- Front and side yard parking
- Basketball goals, vehicles or obstructions on City of San Antonio rights of way
- Grass or weeds higher than 12 inches
- Alley Maintenance Must be free of trash and debris
- Excessive garage and yard sales
- Illegal dumping
- Out-of-cycle brush placed at the curb
- Used appliances, electronics, and discarded furniture left on the curb
- Trailers parked in the street


