POOL CLOSED

Please note the pool is <u>NOT</u> available during swim practice times, May 1st – June 2nd from 4:30 PM – 7:30 PM and June 5th – 23rd from 8:30 AM – 11:30 AM. In addition, the pool will be closed during the swim home meets on 5/27/23 and 6/10/23 from 7 AM to 12 PM.

Please be considerate of the pool maintenance & cleaning staff, who generally maintain the pool on Mondays.

Pool Safety Rules

To ensure the safety of everyone who visits the pool, please abide by the following rules:

- 1. No glass in pool area
- 2. No smoking or vaping
- 3. No running, pushing, or other dangerous horseplay
- 4. Be considerate no yelling or other loud noises
- 5. No animals allowed
- 6. Baby Pool Age 5 and under ONLY
- 7. Children still in diapers must wear swim diapers in the pool (available at the check-in desk for \$1)
- 8. Management and lifeguards reserve the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time
- 9. During unguarded hours, turn off all lights and ensure all doors are closed in the bathrooms



Summer Safety: At the Beach or Pool Side

Remember the Sun can damage your skin by over exposure. Here are some facts to consider before you take a trip.

- 1) 80% of skin cancer occurs on the face, head, and neck. Be generous with sun screen on these parts of the body.
- 2) Recognize the symptoms of heatstroke: Hot dry skin, no sweating, weakness, dizziness, rapid breathing, nausea, & high body temperature.
