TRICKOTREAT



It's also important to protect some other little ones – pets – especially cats ... most


especially black cats. Unfortunately, every year we hear of animals being abused on Halloween. To prevent this, please keep your animals inside or safely secured inside your fenced backyards.

The Woods of Shavano Clubhouse is available to rent for members and non-members. All *full* members are eligible for one free rental plus a \$60 use fee, *after renewing their initial membership*. First time full members, support members, and non-members can also rent the clubhouse for a fee.

The Clubhouse holds up to 52 people. We have eight sixfoot tables, two three-foot tables, and 52 chairs available for use.

A \$100 *refundable* security deposit is required for all events.

- Trimming trees in the Indian Woods Park



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Cast Your Vote!

On **Tuesday**, **November 7**, **2023**, voters will go to the polls for national, state, and local elections. Researching information on candidates is essential for an informed electorate. Choose information from



well-respected sources. Whether you choose to vote by mail, at an early voting polling place, or at the polls on Election Day, remember you have rights and responsibilities when making your voice heard.

If you choose to cast your vote in person, keep these important facts in mind:

- Polls are open from 7 AM 7 PM. If polls close while you are in line, remain in line. You can still vote.
- The last day to apply for a ballot by mail (received, not postmarked, by 5 PM) is Friday, November 3rd.
- The Polling Place for the Woods of Shavano is at the Woods of Shavano Clubhouse located at 13838 Parksite Woods.
- Have an acceptable form of ID with you as well as your Voter Registration card.
- Federal law gives voters the right to receive help if they have trouble reading or writing in English or if they have a disability. Ask if you need help.
- If an election worker is unable to find your name on the list of registered voters, you are still entitled to vote using a provisional ballot.
- If you are subject to aggressive and intimidating questioning about your citizenship status, criminal record, or voting record, it is a federal crime. Report it to the Election Protection Hotline at 866-OUR-VOTE (866-687-8683).

As a citizen, <u>voting is your right</u>, <u>your privilege</u>, and <u>your responsibility</u>.

To Everything There is a Season

Residents of the Woods of Shavano are fortunate to live in an area with such beautiful live oak trees. They provide shade, food and shelter for small animals, beauty, and oxygen for the atmosphere. They are an important part of landscaping in San Antonio. Live oaks are slow-growing trees, but when they reach maturity, they often live one hundred or more years. If one dies, it will take many years for a new one to grow to maturity. Despite their hardiness, they are sometimes susceptible to a disease called oak wilt. One important way to prevent the disease is by proper pruning. Some things to keep in mind when you prune follow:

- Late winter is the ideal time to trim, prune, and reshape trees and large shrubs. Diseases are often transmitted by insects. Most insects are dormant during colder months of the year.
- Trees can be damaged by aggressive pruning. Give trees only a modest reshaping.
- Remove any growth that touches your house. It can cause damage to your home as well as creating a pathway for insects such as carpenter ants to invade the wood on your home.
- Use only disinfected tools when trimming (1 part bleach to 9 parts water). If you hire a company to do the work, make sure they disinfect their tools after each trimming, but especially before they begin work on your trees.
- Tools should be well-sharpened before being used to prune trees.
- Paint or seal cut surfaces. Plant sealants can be purchased from Home Depot, Lowe's, or plant stores. This will lessen the development of fungus or oak wilt.
- Consult a certified arborist if you suspect diseases or insect infestation in your trees and shrubs. They can answer any concerns you have about your trees and recommend any needed treatments.

Keeping your trees in excellent health will provide you with shade and beauty for many years.
