Unguarded Pool Rules and Regulations for Swim at Your Own Risk (SAYOR)

Schedule and Hours of Operation:

SAYOR is available between the hours of 7am and 8pm from April 1 through October 31.

These times and dates may be changed at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

Lifeguarded Hours of Operation:

Lifeguarded hours will be available from the first day of NISD summer vacation until the first day of school. The pool will also be open and guarded on weekends from mid-May until school lets out and also on weekends from when school begins until Labor Day. The lifeguard schedule is as follows:

Monday	Keycard access only
Tuesday	1pm to 8pm
Wednesday	1pm to 8pm
Thursday	1pm to 8pm
Friday	1pm to 9pm
Saturday	1pm to 9pm
Sunday	1pm to 8pm

SAYOR will be available as described above, when the lifeguards are not on duty.

WOSCA Pool Rules During SAYOR:

Members must observe all posted warning signs and follow all WOSCA pool rules.

The gate shall be locked and keycards will need to be scanned to enter the pool area, even during lifeguarded hours.

Members are required to close the gate anytime they are going in or out of the pool area. Propping the gate open and tailgating to enter are prohibited.

Members are prohibited from transferring their keycard to unauthorized persons.

No swimming before or after scheduled SAYOR or lifeguarded dates or hours.

I understand that there is an emergency phone located at the pool to be used only in case of an emergency. In addition, members must have a cell phone for their own use during SAYOR.

SAYOR is not permitted during WOSCA swim team practice, swim meets, pool maintenance or other functions.

No diving is permitted during SAYOR. Diving off of pool equipment or lifeguard stands is not permitted at any time.

No climbing or sitting on lifeguard stands. No bicycles or skateboards on the pool deck at any time.

Members are responsible for themselves, their guests and members of their household in the pool area during SAYOR. Members are liable for any damages caused while using the WOSCA facilities.

Children aged 17 or younger must be supervised by an adult (18 yrs. or older) during SAYOR. A responsible adult must be with a child at the baby pool and within physical reach of a non-swimmer at all times.

Children who are not potty trained will wear commercial swim diapers at all times while in the baby pool or swimming pool. Parents will be held responsible for additional cleaning costs should the pool become contaminated as a result of not adhering to this rule.

Children above age six (6) are not permitted in the baby pool.

Horseplay is strictly prohibited, including but not limited to running, wrestling, dunking, and pushing others into the water.

No food and/or beverages may be consumed in the pool (by state law) and no glass is permitted in the pool or pool area (by state law).

Members are responsible to keep restrooms clean after each use.

Members are responsible for disposal of all garbage in the pool area during SAYOR.

Smoking and vaping are not permitted within the pool area or clubhouse at any time.

Pets are not permitted in the pool area at any time.

The pool must be cleared immediately at the first sound of thunder or sight of lightning.

Members must display their keycard upon request by WOSCA officers, directors, or employees when participating in SAYOR.

Keycards may be deactivated as a result of rule violations and/or nonpayment of fees.

Members will be charged for lost or damaged keycards.
