MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OCTOBER 18, 2007

CALL TO ORDER - President Bob Sons called the meeting to order at _7:00__ p.m. at the Sunset Lake Community Center, Hanauer Hall. All Directors were present except for Steve Kolsto. President Bob Sons stated a quorum had been reached.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 2007 ANNUAL MEETING -

. A motion was made by Cheryl Stine $_$ to approve the minutes and seconded by Bob Gomora . The motion carried.

PRESIDENT'S REMARKS - President Bob Sons welcomed everyone to annual meeting. Bob talked about the tragic loss of Matt Munchalfen. He stated that he was a hard worker and helped a lot of people out here at the lake. Bob said he always had a smile on his face and that when he would pull Matt skiing you could see the look in his face how much he loved the lake. A moment of silence was giving in memory of Matt Munchalfen.

Bob welcomed new members to Sunset Lake Family and the annual meeting. Steve Jacobson #140, Mike & Dottie Colbrook #267,268, Janet Hammond #48, Norman Ryan #119.

Bob addressed a big concern for this year was the weeds. Bob said they are trying to get it under control. The lake has been treated twice and they are hoping to have three maintenance sprays. He also mentioned about handling the algae when it comes up. This will depend on how much rain we get. Please be patient and hopefully we will get control of this problem.

Bob said that we have muskrats here at the lake. The board has hired a trapper, Anthony Thresher, he drives a green Dodge. Bob stated that he has permission to trap muskrats and raccoons. He will be wearing an orange vest. Bob said if anyone is having a problem in their area fell free to talk to him.

Leaf season is coming up Bob mentioned to try not to burn leaves on the rip rap and water ways. This helps feed the weeds in the lake.

Bob said they got a new computer here at the office. They finally can understand some of the reports.

Bob mentioned not to release any animals or stock fish in the lake. He said to let the board handle this. If you have a suggestion come to a board meeting. Bob also said the same thing applies to anyone wanting to put chemicals into the lake. Talk to Bill first before doing spraying or putting on any chemicals.

Boat stickers went pretty well. There are still a few people not wanting to comply. We may have to give out a few fines but overall everyone has complied.

All assessments have been paid in full.

Bob said that they have done some clean up on abandon property. They will stay up on this. There have been a lot of transfers this year. It looks like about thirty one transfers.

Bob addressed that if someone has a complaint they need to fill out a complaint form before the board will take action.

Bob said that some people talked to him about fast times but he will address it in new business. Bob said that they received over 5,000.00 in donations for fireworks. He said that a lot of business donated also and that he appreciated all the donations. Bob mentioned he had a lot fun blowing up things. Bob said that this next 4th of July lands on a Friday. He would like to have a DJ and have a little party at his house this year - everyone is invited. Bob also thank Norm Brand for all his hard work on the fishing tournament. Bob said that they are looking for some

volunteers to take over the fishing tournament for June 16th & 17th. The catfish tournament will start on Friday night and bass on Saturday that way we take care of both fishermen. Anyone interest see Bob Sons or Norm Brand.

Bob thanked the board for all their hard work. He said they have a good group and it is a privilege to work with them. Also thanked Kristy. Bob mentioned that he has worked with Bill a lot this year and said that Bill starts early and goes non stop all day. Bob said that Bill is amazing and he saves the lake a lot. Bob mentioned how much they appreciate him.

Bob said a big thanks to everyone and hope everything goes smooth.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Bill Hohimer stated that he wanted to thank everyone that helped with the ice and snow. He mentioned how much he appreciated the help with all the brush. Bill said he picked up four dogs this year and sent them to the pound. Bill stated that two children were bit this year and mentioned for everyone to watch your animals.

AQUATIC CONTROL & WATER SAFETY-SAM LAMENDOLA: Sam Lamendola stated that he had redone 36 signs on the lake. Sam thanked Mike Chosich and Tony Leopardi for their help. Sam mentioned that they didn't put them back in the small coves. If anyone needs one in their cove let Sam know. Sam stated that the lot numbers are a big help to identify who the boat belongs to. Sam also mentioned that the lot numbers and sticker will be enforced heavy this year. Sam talked about stocking the lake. They stocked 2400 catfish and 1000 hybrid bluegill. Sam talked to Jeff Pontnack about what he recommends and he said large mouth bass and walleye.

BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE- GEORGE TOEPFER: George Toepfer stated they had another good year here at the lake. Two - new homes, two - garages, one - patio, five - decks, ten - boat docks, and eight - sheds.

DAM & GROUNDS COMMITTEE-John Kemp: John Kemp stated the dam is in pretty good shape. The inspection was done last year. John is checking to make sure we are up to date on the permit. There are a few issues on the lines. They are taking care of this. The grounds are in good shape. When John took over there were about thirty leaf letters. John followed up on those. They resulted in a couple of fines but all was taken care of. John stated the board sent out a letter after the ice storm for help. We had an overwhelming response. This was great. John reminded everyone that if you cut a tree down make sure and fill out a permit and get permission from Bill Hohimer or John. John also reminded everyone that it has been dry and to be careful with leaf fires.

LEGAL & INSURANCE COMMITTEE-Norm Brand: Norm Brand stated that they are going to put the insurance out for bid. Norm will check and see if we can save any money and get the same coverage. Everything else is fine.

ROADS COMMITTEE-BOB GOMORA: Bob Gomora stated we did North Lake and all the road construction for \$12,694.85. Bob mentioned that oil & gravel prices are going up and so the prices for roads are going up. Bob stated that if anyone has a hole in the road, they will do the best job they can to patch it up. Each year they do a section of road so eventually we catch your road. We received 350 ton of chips from North Otter Township at no charge thanks to Bill Hohimer and his contacts. Bob also talked about the neighborhood watch is going pretty good. He reminded everyone to write down information and call Sherriff's office. Bob stated they had some trouble with a 4 wheeler's and they got it taken care of. Bob also talked about the speed limit and reminded everyone to follow the rules.

SANITATION, SHORELINE & BOAT DOCKS COMMITTEE-TONY PAQUETTE:

Tony Paquette stated that everyone is has been keeping chlorine in the containers. Tony said most people are doing a pretty good job on their rip rap. Tony mentioned that if you don't have any chlorine they will leave a note and go back and check in about ten days. Tony addressed that rip rap is something that people should pay attention all year long. At least check it twice a year. Rip rap is not taken care of just when you sell your house but the whole time your live there. Tony said rip rap is there for a reason and that the board would appreciate if you would pay attention to this. Tony stated that boat docks for the most part have been good. Tony mentioned that if it hold his weight that is good. He said that they have one boat dock that doesn't look very good and they are going to address this. Tony talked about Jim Seggelke and how he has done the checking on the septics. Jim has a print out when he has checked the septic and what he found. Tony said the septics are checked twice a year. A big thank you to Jim Seggelke for all his help. Tony also said that we have a very nice lake and to keep up the good work.

WATER QUALITY & CONSERVATION-STEVE KOLSTO:

Steve Kolsto absent due to the death of a close friend. Bob Sons gave Steve's report. Thanked Paul & Shirley Early for their dedication and the love of the lake. The Early's have done testing for the lake which is very much appreciated. Bob Sons also said that after sampling they found that the water quality of the lake is very good. They have found one area that there is a problem and the board has acted on that. Hopefully this will be taken care of by spring time. They are going to get together with Bob Williamson to discuss a maintenance program for the treatment of the coontail and algae. Steve's term is up this year. He said he would be happy to serve but if not he will enjoy just living on the lake with everyone.

FINANCE (APPROVAL OF 2008 BUDGET) - CHERYL STINE:

Cheryl Stine stated that she appreciated Kristy helping her with her job by entering the invoices, income and expenses for lake. Cheryl stated that she would turn the rest of her report over to Bob Sons. Bob Sons discussed the budget. Bob talked about the change in the interest and they took the extra money that it generated and put it towards the weed control. Bob asked if there were any questions. No questions were asked a motion was made to accept the budget.

Upon a motion made by _Bob Gomora_and seconded by _Ray Reardon_to except the budget as proposed. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS –President Bob Sons asked if there was any old business. Karla Dork #87 asked if they were just spraying certain coves. She mentioned that Lot#7 was upset. Bob Sons said that they will not spray everything they need some habitat for the fish. John Kemp explained about how they surveyed and when they came to spray they ended up spraying more places than what they surveyed for. Bob Gomora reminded everyone about if you go to other lakes to make sure and clean your boats off before going back into Sunset Lake.

NEW BUSINESS – Bob Sons talked about fast times on the lake. Bob said that several fishermen are speeding in the morning to get to their fishing spot. Bob mentioned that different people approached him about the fast times, so he wanted to bring it up at the annual meeting for a vote.

A motion was made by George Madiar to leave the speed the same and was seconded by Shirley Early. Motion carried.

After much discussion about changing the times for fast days it was decided that the majority spoke that it be left the same.
