MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OCTOBER 15, 2009

CALL TO ORDER - President Bob Sons called the meeting to order at _7:05_ p.m. at the Sunset Lake Community Center, Hanauer Hall. All Directors were present. President Bob Sons stated a quorum had been reached.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE 2009 ANNUAL MEETING -

PRESIDENT'S REMARKS - President Bob Sons welcomed everyone to Sunset Lake Annual Meeting. New members introduced themselves were Alex Hardy #127, Greg Stuckey #165, Camilla Winterland #50, Coleen Mays #32, and Ron Kuethe #103. Bob said we had a pretty good year. The water was up and weeds are down and pretty well under control. Now that the water is down about 31/2 it is a good time to address the rip rap & boat docks. If you can not get it done by Thanksgiving let the board know and they will keep the water down a little longer. Bob thanked all the people that donated their time and hard work on the rip rap for the island. John Kemp, Nick Thomas, Jim Seggelke, Mel Lomelino, Bill Urban, Bill Walkenbach, Bill Hohimer, Steve Kolsto, Steve Jacobson, Greg Stuckey, Sam Lamendola, john Mount, John Earley, Mike Stine, Norm Brand, Ray Reardon and Hank Sutton. Hank Sutton also donated the boat and barge for this project. He also thanked Coleen Mays & Camilla Winterland for making lunch for everyone. Bob stated they placed about 150 ton of rock. The island is looking great. Bob said he wanted to also thank all the people that helped with the fishing tournament Norm Brand, Steve Kolsto, Jim Seggelke, Bill Urban, Bill Hohimer, and John Kemp. Without there hard work and help of the sponsors and fisherman and all those who donated to the 4th of July it was a great success. I hope everyone enjoyed the show. Bob spent close to \$12,000.00. Bob mentioned that the new web site is up and running. You can see it at www.sunsetlakegirard.com. Bob thanked Steve Kolsto and Amy Walkenbach for all the work they do testing the lake. They do all this on their own time. Debbie Westendorf made the calendars and she is donating the money for the fireworks. She also made the afghan flag which is being raffled with the trolling motor on Father's Day. You can sign up at the office for the calendars and raffle tickets. Bob thanked Sandy Richey for snacks. She is a wonderful cook. Lastly Bob thanked Bill and Kristy for wonderful job.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Bill Hohimer stated wanted to thank the ladies at the lake. Bill mentioned that they help at the fishing tournaments, the work down at the ramp, and wiener roast with their great cooking. Sandy Richey, Coleen Mays, Camilla Winterland, Liz Seggelke, Eileen Jones, Mary Hagenbuck, Cheryl Johnson & Maxine Hohimer and several others. Bill also said that he had a great board to work with. Bill stated how much they volunteer and that appreciates all they do. Bill mentioned that we have rock, straw, fabric if you would need it for your shoreline. If you have any old scrap iron we have a source to get rid of these items. Bill said that he cut trees, build up the roads & driveways and helps wherever he can. He said that he does driveways in the winter after the roads are plowed. Turn on porch light. Bill mentioned he has help with the plowing. Bill said to burn leaves when you take them to the burn piles. If the piles get to big this can be dangerous and can easily get out of hand.

AQUATIC CONTROL & WATER SAFETY-SAM LAMENDOLA: Sam Lamendola stated on safety a few people are still speeding between the island and dam and no wake areas. There have been some tickets issued for speeding. Sam also said that they had to replace some signs and move the buoys. Sam asked that people leave the buoys alone as this is a safety issue. He mentioned that they will not be stocking the lake this year. The money will be used for boat ramp & rip rap. Sam said that he will call Jeff from DNR about shocking the lake in April or May. Last shocking was done five years ago. Sam mentioned about the fishing tournaments and how good the fishing has been. Sam suggested that everyone read the Rules & Regulations.

BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE- GEORGE TOEPFER: George Toepfer stated it was a good year with 5 boat docks, 4 docks or deck extension, 1 new home and 2 homes in process, 2 sheds, 1 sunroom, & 2 patios.

DAM & GROUNDS COMMITTEE-John Kemp: John Kemp stated he wanted to thank Jim Seggelke for helping John out this year. He has helped on the tower, ground and property inspections. John was involved with getting the treatment done on the weeds. John said Bill Urban helps with the map when they go out and spray. Bill marks where they spray on a map. John and Jim have been working on the tower. They looked at the patch on the tower that is deteriorating. This will have to be fixed. John talked about extending the boat ramp. John also mentioned about working on the face of the dam and the walls of the spillway. They will need a little maintenance work. John helped Bill with goose eggs.

LEGAL & INSURANCE COMMITTEE-Norm Brand: Norm Brand stated that everything has been pretty good this year. Two assessments have not been paid. Norm mentioned that insurance is up for renewal. He said they will probably put it out for bid on a three year term or will go year to year. Norm thanked all the volunteers for their help on the rip rap/boat dock. Norm mentioned how much money they saved by having volunteers and not having to hire it done or raise assessments. Norm mentioned that assessments actually went down three dollars.

ROADS COMMITTEE-Tony Paquette: Tony Paquette stated that there are no real changes. Tony said they put a few more dollars in the budget for next year. They will have a little larger area to do. Tony mentioned that before the snow comes make sure to move any structures that you have or mark them with a reflector. This will help when they plow. Tony said if anyone has questions he will be available after the meeting.

SANITATION, SHORELINE & BOAT DOCKS COMMITTEE—Jim Seggelke: Jim Seggelke stated he thanked everyone for their cooperation with chlorine in the septic. Jim said this helps to keep the lake clean. Jim mentioned that if anyone is leaving for the winter to make sure chlorine bottle is full. Jim said this should last for the winter. Jim mentioned about the lake being down and it is a good time to address your rip rap and boat down.

WATER QUALITY & CONSERVATION-Steve Kolsto:

Steve Kolsto absent but gave Bob Sons this information.

Steve & Amy Walkenbach have been taking samples in three sites on the lake and delivering them to the labs in Springfield since the beginning of May until the end of September. The sample includes secchi transparency, water chemistry, dissolved oxygen and temperature. Water quality of Sunset Lake is excellent. Fecal samples that are traditionally taken in the fall were not taken this year in response to our labs feeling that we might be able to tell more once the lake fills back up in the spring. A second fecal sample will be taken sometime after the 4th of July when the lake is heavily used. Steve also wanted to thank John Kemp for helping monitor the lake.

FINANCE (APPROVAL OF 2010 BUDGET) - Cheryl Stine:

Cheryl Stine stated she thanked everyone for all their hard work. Cheryl said our total income for the year is 92% which is right on target. Fine and penalties were low. Expenses are at 80%. We are using the funds from weeds & fish to help with repairs. Cheryl also mentioned they did not want to stock fish when the lake is being lowered. Cheryl discussed the 2010 budget. Assessments have been lowered three dollars and they added more in the budget for the roads. Upon a motion made by _Don Burgess _and seconded by _Dave Campbell to except the budget as proposed. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS –President Bob Sons stated if there was any old business nothing was mentioned.

NEW BUSINESS –. Fast and Slow Time is being proposed from noon to 8:00pm. The Fast and Slow Time did not pass. The vote was 56 no and 54 yes.

Bob mentioned that we have thirty free tickets to Macoupin Senior Center Branson Show November 14th if anyone is interested see Kristy in the office.

John Earley made a motion to close the nominations and seconded by Olyn Hines.

Mike Colbrook was declared the director for a 1-year term.
