History: History of MVA with neck pain.

Procedure: AP and lateral views of the lumbar spine are submitted.

Findings:

A shallow left lumbar convexity is present, with the pelvis residing low on the left. Straightening of the lumbar lordosis is noted. The bone density is normal. Mild disc narrowing and spondylophyte formation are visualized at L3-L4 and L4-L5. Mild right facet hypertrophy is identified at L5-S1. The osseous neural foramina are clear. The sacroiliac and hip articulations are normal. The soft tissues are normal.

Impression:

- 1. Mild degenerative disc disease at L3-L4 and L4-L5.
- 2. Mild right facet arthrosis at L5-S1.
- 3. Postural alterations.
