Eligibility requirements:

- Must be the child or grandchild of a service member (active, guard, or reserve) or honorably discharged veteran of the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, or Space Force.
- Must be a senior at East or West Jessamine High School, or a homeschool academy, residing in Jessamine County.
- Must be pursuing a 2-year or 4-year degreed program beginning not later than the fall semester immediately following graduation from high school.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
