Dear Residents:

The Board of Directors has been reviewing our regulations related to fireworks. While Georgia law allows for the purchase of fireworks in our state, the use of fireworks, of any kind or size, by Residents within the Washington Square community is strictly prohibited.

Fireworks shall be defined as any device containing restricted amounts of pyrotechnic composition, designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion. Fireworks shall include any combustible or explosive composition or any substance or combination of substances or article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration, or detonation, including but not limited to blank cartridges, firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, bombs, sparklers, and other combustibles and explosives of like construction, as well as articles containing any explosive or flammable compound and tablets and other devices containing an explosive substance.

The fine for using, setting off, lighting, igniting, illuminating and/or displaying fireworks is \$250.00 for each incident.

If you have any questions regarding these new rules and regulations, please submit them in writing to propertymanager@washingtonsquareatlanta.com and the Board or management will respond to your concerns. The Board is hopeful that all residents of Washington Square will comply with these rules and regulations and be respectful of their neighbors.
