Tips for People with Arthritis from the Arthritis Foundation

- <u>Time your tasks to prevent pain.</u> Prepare for dinner at midday if your hands tend to hurt in the evening. Bathe and prep the night before if morning stiffness makes tasks tough.
- <u>Sit to save joints.</u> When you are tired and in pain, sit while doing common

activities. For example, use a stool while washing dishes. <u>Take steps to prevent falls.</u>

Reduce tripping hazards by picking up clutter, taping down or removing throw rugs, and keeping your home well lit; perhaps with a night lights. Install a non-slip bath mat and grab bars in your bathroom, and make sure staircases are in good repair and have railings.

• Get a grip.

Give handles of commonly used items, like a toothbrush and kitchen utensils more grip by wrapping them with rubber bands or foam insulation used for small pipes.

• <u>Choose good shoes.</u>

Wearing ill-fitting shoes can cause pain in your feet and throw off your gait, which can lead to more joint, muscle, and other problems and pain. Invest in professionally fitted low heel shoes with good structure.

• Set your clock.

If you're taking all your meds at once in the morning or at night, stop and read instructions. Drugs that cause drowsiness or nausea are better in the night, while others are more effective in the morning, unless ordered for more times than once a day. Always follow your doctors orders and the advice of your pharmacist. Never make changes without consulting first.
