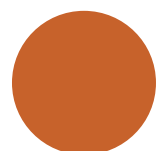
Color Logo

Use the color version of our logo whenever possible.



B&W Logo

When printing in black & white, use the B&W logo file instead of letting your software convert automatically.



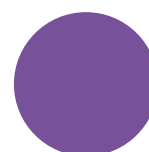

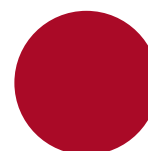

ALWAYS...

...use the official logo files provided by ARC



...leave blank space around the logo (nothing else should touch it)



...spell out the full name (Arlee Rehabilitation Center) the first time it's used in a document. After that, it can be abbreviated ARC.

NEVER...

...combine the logo with another piece of artwork



...change the colors of the logo. Use the full-color or B&W versions as provided only.



...alter, stretch, or adjust contrast of the logo, or extract logo elements to use on their own.

Font Guidelines

Consistently using the same typefaces gives us a “look” that’s the same for all of our documents.

Alegreya

Use lighter weights for body copy in printed documents, heavier weights for headlines online.

Alegreya is an elegant typeface designed for use in literature. It has a soft, classic look.

Alegreya Sans

Use thin or light weights for body copy online, and heavier weights for printed headlines.

The italics stand out more than most sans-serif fonts, making them great for emphasis.

Both typefaces are available from Google Fonts and are licensed under the Open Font License.
