



WHAT IS A PINTO ...



The difference between a Pinto and a Paint horse is that the Pinto horse can be from an array of many bloodlines and The Pinto Horse Association of America recognizes 57 horse, pony, miniature, utility and 10 Long Ear outcross breeds. The American Paint Horse is limited to registered bloodlines of Paint, American Quarter Horse and Thoroughbred horses only.

WHAT IS THE PINTO HORSE ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA...

The Pinto Horse Society started in the 1930s with the purpose of breeding superior colored horses. The current Pinto Horse Association of America was incorporated in 1956 and includes more than 88,000 members and 157,000 Pinto horses, ponies, miniatures and utility horses and a Long Ear Division registry for donkey and mules.

<u>There are 10 different types of annual and lifetime membership in PtHA:</u> Individual, Youth, Amateur, Novice, Joint, Assumed or Trade Name, Corporate, Syndicate or Joint Venture, Decendent's Estate, Trust or Guardianship or other legal custodial entities partnership.

The PtHA® has evolved through the years and now has three separate registries: the Color Registry, the Solid Registry, and the Long Ear Registry. All equines, no matter the size or breeding, can now qualify to be registered in one of the three PtHA® Registries.

The Color Breed Registry

Registration and Transfer of Horses, Ponies, Miniatures & Utility equine with Color <u>The Solid Registry</u> Registration and Transfer of Solid Horses, Ponies, Miniatures & Utility equine <u>Long Ear Registry</u> Registration and Transfers of Mules and Donkeys

This versatile association offers many avenues of involvement for members. From riding your horse in the show ring or out on the trail, PtHA® members can receive awards for spending time with their Pintos. With two international shows and an annual convention, PtHA® members gather together several times a year to make memories and enjoy their Pintos!

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR PINTO ...



Pinto horses can be registered directly through The Pinto Horse Association of America or through a PtHA Field Representative. To register a Pinto directly through PtHA, visit their website at www.ptha.org to download all membership and registration application forms. PtHA Field Representatives can be found at most PtHA horse shows and can inspect your horse, fill out the necessary paperwork and assign a temporary PtHA number that allows you to show immediately and is good for three months. The Field Representative will then forward the paperwork to PtHA and a permanent number will be assigned. Please see the PtHA website for complete information on registration requirements including color, approved outcross breeds, sizes, etc.

PAPERWORK NEEDED FOR WPTHA HORSE SHOWS...

- Copy of current National PtHA Membership Card for Owner and Exhibitor, if applicable. Also, a copy of current Amateur and/or Youth National PtHA Membership Card(s), if applicable. (All Memberships can be obtained at the show.)
- Copy of current National PtHA Registration Paper for the Horse, Pony, or Miniature to be shown. (On-site PtHA Registration is available at all Wisconsin PtHA Horse Shows for qualified horses.)
- Copy of all applicable paperwork—including PtHA Lease Notification Form, Family Relationship Form, etc. SEE OUR WEBSITE FOR COMPLETE INFORMATION.
- Copy of current negative Coggins Test. PLEASE NOTE: The State of Wisconsin requires all out-of-state horses to have a current Health Certificate—please bring a copy of this as well.

Any of the above items not provided to the Show Office may result in disqualification.
