Board Election Policy and Procedure

Policy 215

Adopted by Naytahwaush Community Charter School Board: April 24, 2008

Revised: July 11, 2016

- 1. An election committee shall be formed at the March board of directors' meeting each year. Board members who are running for election are ineligible to serve on the committee.
- 2. Every parent/legal guardian whose contact information is on file at NCCS will be sent a ballot in April, along with NCCS employees and school board members.
- 3. Ballots will be due and collected at a specific time and date in May.
- 4. In the event of a tie, there will be a run-off election in May.
- 5. The Board will certify election results at the May board meeting. Run-off election results, if needed, will be certified at the June board meeting.
- 6. Newly elected board members may attend the June meeting, but will not be voting members until the July meeting.
