Yet Most of all with years and years of experience on sets of major motion pictures and TV series she has learned one major lesson, knowing when to keep your big mouth shut. Knowing how to communicate with actors, producers, directors, and crew. And that experience comes from implementation of the work. The respect she acquired over the years was earned.

INTERVIEW WITH THE DIRECTOR:

WHERE DID YOU GET THE IDEA FOR THE FILM ?:

When my father died and as the years past it was the smallest things that made me think of him. It was the smell of a pastrami sandwich, or something he gave me from his travels. My dad was a man of few words, yet his actions were always done for the right reason and made powerful silent statements. My husband is the same way. So this idea kept floating in my mind. It's not the big things in life that change us or affect us profoundly, it those small caring gestures that make our hearts and souls sing. It's the smallest of things it the smallest of actions that we remember. We remember the kindness and love in those actions. Yet when we remember those lovely moments it never the words spoken, but the actions taken that we feel in our souls. So I was determined to create a wordless story that reflect those silent moments and would touch the soul.

HOW DID YOU SHOOT THE FILM?:

I shot the film myself on a digital camera. Not having to worry about sound I set out to shoot 'The Scarf' only concerning myself with the emotions of the subject matter.

WHAT DOES THE SCARF ITSELF REPRESENT?

The Scarf is love, kindness, compassion and caring. A gift of any kind is a delight yet it is the thought behind the gift that makes it priceless to the individual.

AFTER SO MANY YEARS AS A SCRIPT SUPERVISOR WHAT MADE YOU DECIDE TO WRITE AND DIRECT?

I was on a TV show in Vancouver Canada and was working with a very famous US producer. We were nearing the end of production and I was invited to a private dinner with the director and producers. During this dinner my life changed. I was sitting across from the writer/producer and we began trading stories. His stories of his Irish background and mine of my Cuban/ Russian background. When Monday came around he approached me on the set and said,

"Why aren't you writing? Your a story teller. No one out stories me at a dinner and your stories and the way you tell them are outstanding."

That very week I signed up for classes in writing and purchased books and have never stopped learning about telling stories and writing in script form.

Carlos J. Pappe as Husband:

<u>Main Hero:</u> he is the strong silent type. Doing the right thing for the right reason. He is the caretaker and gives this care with love and devotion.

<u>Gipsy Lodos</u> as Wife:

<u>Maiden:</u> The wife who has learned to except that her husband is her caretaker. Her love only grows as she excepts and understands her days are numbered.

Betty Bennett as the Stranger:
