Born in Cuba to a Russian Jewish civil engineer father and Cuban Catholic script supervisor mother, having a multicultural and multi-religious family there was no escaping compelling and profoundly interesting points of view on life that help in her storytelling.

Betty's mom was one of the first Latin Americans in the IATSE so basically Betty was born into the business. She studied for years under her mothers watchful eyes and then was advised to study editing, so she did. She became an assistant editor and joined the IATSE local 161 out of New York and also become a duel citizen of the USA and Canada and became a member of the IATSE of Canada local 891. She worked with the best in the industry for years.

With many friends in the industry in there 'A' game ready willing and able to help, production began. Then suddenly hurricane Irma hit south Florida. This event caused many changes in the schedule. With those changes she lost many of the people that had agreed to work and help her with her movie. Not one to be deterred, Betty forged forward.

Betty resolute in her knowledge and capability of her abilities, was determined to make her movie predominantly herself, knowing she never desired to hear the words: "She was carried."

With writing, directing, producing, and director of photography hat on and encompassing many other hats, she shot. 'Soils of Evil.'

What is required to accomplish such a daunting task?

Patience, much experience, organizational skill, screen direction perfection, communication skills, and a true understanding that cast and crew need to feel appreciated, validated, accommodated, and lets not forget compensated.

If it were not enough to release a feature film ('Soils of Evil') she is also releasing 2 short silent films 'The Scarf' and 'The Scarf 2'. Betty Bennett feels if one can tell a story in silence, without a word spoken in her two shorts, one truly is a story teller.

<u>SYNOPSIS</u>

WORLD

Yet Most of all with years and years of experience on sets of major motion pictures and TV series she has learned one major lesson, knowing when to keep your big mouth shut. Knowing how to communicate with actors, producers, directors, and crew. And that experience comes from implementation of the work.

INTERVIEW WITH THE DIRECTOR:

Inspired by true events, who's events?

Inspired by my life, my eclectic, egocentric life that one lives thinking as one grows up is normal. Yet having a Russian Jewish father and a Cuban Catholic mother is very interesting and unusual. I never thought much about it till I heard others talk about their lives and I would say to myself. What? No drama, no this or that??? Really??? With all that, add dyslexia and I view the world in an unusual upside down and backwards way that makes me, me. My entire life I've been a curious individual. Always asking thousands of questions. Questions that when I was a child would make adults uncomfortable. My Grandpa, a Cantor was the one who had the patience to listen, he understood me and would guide my curious mind in many directions and make me think things through. My world was unique, something I did not realize as a child and that world of polar opposite opinions and points of view made me the story teller I am today.

Was it painful to write 'Soils of Evil'?

I have traveled many roads in my life. I never took the easy path. I wouldn't say it was painful, I would say the hardest character to nail down was Isabel, my mother. She was not easy to explain. After my mothers death which came just before shooting was to begin, I heard the dark secrets of my mother's life. With those secrets revealed I had a better understanding of who she was and why? Now with the new secrets revealed of my mothers life, I have a new script I'm working on about her life in Cuba in the 1930's. I have more ideas I am working on. Once I got 'Soils of Evil' out of my soul, other ideas began pouring out of me.

How many days did it take to shoot 'Soils of Evil'?

It took 19 days to shoot 'Soils of Evil'. I would prep during the week Monday through Friday. Thank you to my husband Carlos J. Pappe executive producer who got the honey do list of making props, painting and more. I was the organizer of shot list and prepping wardrobe and props and such. Then we would shot on the weekends. I am proud to say we would shoot for 8 hours a day. And of course breakfast was always available and lunch came 6 hours into the day. I was extremely organized and I would shoot only what was needed as I edited in my head and knew what I wanted and was very aware of what I didn't need. With Screen direction perfection as I call it, one can get away with infinite amounts of cheating. I would shoot and the crew and cast was completely confused because I could be in the same yard and say, now your in the neighbors yard look this direction and it was confusing them and I would say, "Just close your eyes for a moment and imagine your in the neighbors yard". They did as I directed, they could not believe that it would work until they saw the final product.

I learned from the old timers the old way, that a director must have a profound understanding of all departments. With that understanding comes the ability to communicate with knowledge, power and wisdom. Once a crew realizes you are knowledgeable they are open to suggestions and communication. For they realize one took the time to understand what they do and why they do it. And that provides a bridge for all involved. Once that connection is built with respect and confidence, dreams and magic present themselves on a movie set.

Logical Rational Thinker: Milton is 'Dad', Isabel's husband and Sarah's father. He is kind, giving, nurturing and very unsuspecting and naive individual. He has been taken advantage of and tries hard to keep the peace for the sake of his daughter, Sarah.

"I'll tell Maria to cook your favorite. Kinda like a last supper."



<u>Ally:</u> Maria is the caretaker of the family. She is blind, yet she sees all and hears even more. She is the protector of all especially Sarah and her son Carlos.

<u>Matias Aqnese</u> as Carlos

"I think that evil comes in many forms. Inside, outside, above us and below. But I think that, it is up to us to distinguish from where it comes from and to decide if we choose to travel its path."



<u>Sidekick/Ally</u>: Carlos is Maria's son and Sarah's best friend. His job is to keep an eye on Sarah and keep her out of trouble.

<u>Randy Molnar</u> as Grandpa:

"Simple indication of a foreshadowing that a revelation is near. Or it could be as simple as they are in need of love."



<u>Wise Old Man</u>: Grandpa is Milton's father and Sarah's Grandpa. He is wise and is aware of more then most. His silence is beyond knowledge it is wisdom. He worked his entire life and he is making sure his family benefits from all his hard work.
