Grading Awards Policy

Curriculum and Syllabus – Limitations and guidance

The body of knowledge in the sport of Sambo is vast, therefore it is not feasible to develop a curriculum to cover all areas of the sport, however, the syllabus as developed is a guideline and contains the minimum requirements for reach award.

Colours of awards and indicating awards on uniform

Colours of the awards match other systems and are yellow, orange, green, blue, brown, black.

It is recommended that tags are placed on the end of the belt to indicate the award or coloured belts are worn in club and seminar environments, however, students and coaches are reminded that a coloured belt other than the appropriate colour for the Khurtka worn is not allowed at national or international competition.

Timescales

grading periods are recommended as 6 monthly for the lower awards and annually for the higher awards.

Requirements for granting awards

Level 1 coach can award up to orange Level 2 Coach can award up to Green Level 3 coach can award up to Blue National coach and higher is required for awards up to Brown Competition success is required for full Black award

Limitation of Competition only pathway and exception for technical award

In exceptional circumstances Black award may be given for non competitive grades, who cannot compete due to personal or medical circumstances, however, this should be an exception and based on age, experience, previous competitive history and the existing limitation preventing contest
