Ambulance Report-. Beau Williams reporting. They are struggling with the auditors. If they find something wrong, they won't tell you how to fix it. A discussion was had concerning blood draws for the Sheriff's Department. The problems are with the cost of materials and lawyers. Grant money is still coming. They changed the CD's and should get twice as much in interest.
