Be part of our PDR emergency response team

The City's CERT program is a seven-week training that will provide you with disaster-preparedness, response tools and knowledge. The program is open to Sunnyvale residents. There are three sessions a year. CERT training covers a wide range of emergency preparedness topics, including:

- Disaster medical operations
- Search and rescue
- Fire safety and suppression
- Using the incident command system
- Critical stress management
